Art Blenk Scholarship

Scholarship Criteria

- Applicants must be one of the following:
 - o A family member of an active member of Marine Corps League Detachment 873.

Ωľ

O A high school senior enrolled in a JROTC program in Horry / Georgetown counties planning to attend a post- secondary institution.

or

- A veteran residing in Horry / Georgetown Counties planning to attend a post-secondary institution.
- Applicants must not already possess a post-secondary degree.
- Applicants must be contemplating <u>full time study</u> at a post-secondary program that includes, two-year degree programs, four-year degree programs or vocational schools.
- Applicants must submit an application completely, provide all required documentation and mail back to: Marine Corps League Detachment 873, Attn: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 1104, Murrells Inlet, SC 29576. All applications must be postmarked no later than <u>June 13th</u>, 2025.
- Applicants, both high school, college, and veteran, must provide an official transcript, or if
 already attending a post-secondary program must submit official cumulative transcripts as of the
 most recent academic period. The transcripts must have a watermark or have embossed
 identification.
- Veterans must also provide a copy of their DD214.
- Applicants must submit a written essay summarizing why they deserve the scholarship. The essay should be no more than 500 words, double spaced and in twelve-point font. The essay should include specifics such as extracurricular activities, awards and recognition, examples of leadership skills and ability, employment history, as well as relevant personal and family attributes. It should state any relationship of the applicant to the family member who is an active member of Detachment 873 or the applicants time in service if applicable.
- Applicants must provide a letter of recommendation from a non-family member.
- Applicants may be asked for a personal interview and references may be verified at the sole discretion of Marine Corps League Detachment # 873.
- Awardees will be notified no later than August 15th.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to submit an "Official Fulltime Enrollment Letter" by October 1 of each year that they are awarded the Art Blenk Scholarship. Scholarships will be paid directly to the educational institution and applied to the student's account. Awards may be used for any purpose including room, board, books, and tuition.
