Military Appreciation Days OVERVIEW

Since the early days of World War II, Myrtle Beach was a military town. The United States Army Air Corps opened formal operations in March 1942 at the Myrtle Beach Bombing and Gunnery Training Range. During the war it also served as a Prisoner of War encampment for German POWs. From the 1950s to the 1990s, the Myrtle Beach Air Force Base operated and was a key employer in the Grand Strand. The United States Air Force closed the base in 1993, and subsequently the base property was transformed into the Market Common District; and the Myrtle Beach International Airport. To observe Myrtle Beach's military history, the Myrtle Beach Military Appreciation Days celebrates those who have served our great nation. This year, Myrtle Beach will host the Traveling Vietnam Memorial Wall Exhibit.


