Scott Dulebohn is the CEO for The Veterans Welcome Home and Resource Center (VWHRC), a 501C3 non-profit in Little River, South Carolina. The VWHRC assists honorably discharged veterans with homelessness, food, job placement, financial support, VA disability claims, education assistance, spouse support, and providing resources.

Scott grew up in Lima, Ohio and later moved to Marion, Ohio where he graduated from Ridgedale High School. Scott and his wife Amber moved to North Myrtle Beach, South Carolina after high school and opened a sign company with his father Jim, Quality Signs & Designs. After 2 years Scott joined the United States Air Force and was stationed at Andrews Air Force Base. He had the honor of being a fire fighter/EMT and protecting our President on Air Force 1. While serving our country he learned a great deal, but nothing more important than respect.



After an injury and military service coming to an end Scott turned to education and completed 4 degrees: AA General - College of Southern Maryland, AS Criminal Justice - College of Southern Maryland, BS Homeland Security - University of Maryland Global College, MS Homeland Security & Emergency Management - University of Maryland Global College. During this time Scott also continued to make signs and became heavily involved volunteering at Forest Park Church with his wife Amber and three children Maximus, Elyssa, and Vanessa. Life was very busy and exciting for them, but never too busy to help serve.

Scott jumped back into firefighting with the federal government at Pax River Navy Base in Southern Maryland after completing college. He transferred to Camp Lejeune Fire Department and lived in Surf City, North Carolina to be closer to family and sunshine. Unfortunately, another back injury forced Scott into back surgery and retirement, but opened up moving to Little River, South Carolina where he volunteered at the Veterans Welcome Home and Resource Center.

Scott and his family love to be at the beach and pool, all day long! He enjoys baseball, hockey, playing golf, shooting guns, fast cars, and being in the sun. Scott and his family are very excited to settle down in Little River and grow some roots. He truly looks forward to meeting with you and helping in any way possible.
