

GUIDE TO FILMING B4B VIDEOS

HELP THE VOLUNTEER EFFORTS OF B4B...

It has taken a decade to video, edit, and upload the 1000+ videos that are published on our B4B YouTube Channel (https://www.youtube.com/bound4burlingame). Before the videos, B4B originally photographed all sites and published them online. (still available at (http://photos.bound4burlingame.com). Through the seasons, trees fall/grow, foliage blooms and the terrain changes. Help B4B stay current by using your cellphone to video empty campsites/cabins when you see one. #neverenough #forcampersbycampers

FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

- 1. *IMPORTANT*~Turn your phone horizontal.
- 2. Start at entrance to campsite, film 5 seconds of the campsite # painted on the rock.
- 3. From the entrance, scan upward/downward to show tree coverage and terrain. Then, move forward. Walk slow and steady into the center/rear of the campsite, keeping the camera around chest level.
- 4. SLOWLY turn 360 degrees in a circle to video the area of the campsite. End video.
- 5. Video should be 1:15 maximum.
- 6. Send footage to bound4burlingame@gmail.com or send a private message through B4B Facebook and ask for cell # to send to (easiest & quickest method).
 - *Note- Videos can no longer be saved by sending through messenger.
