- 1) Each player is their own score keeper. Use the Shuffle-It Score Card to help track all your points and be sure to add any bonus points.
- 2) What is the "Word of the Day"? _____
- 3) Add all points together on the Letter and Blank Cards used to form a word and put it in the "Word Score" column of the scorecard. Add all bonus points scored and put it in the "Total Bonus Points" column. Add the "Word Score" + the "Total Bonus Points" together to equal the "Total Word Score". Add all the "Total Word Scores" together to equal the "Total Game Score".
Bonus Points:
10 points for scoring 7 card word
20 points for scoring 10 card word
30 points for scoring 13+ card word
40 points for scoring the "Word of the Day"

There is no limit on the number of times you can score the "Word of the Day" in a game, but it must be at least 5 letters and may include blanks or must be at least 4 letters with no blanks. Example: Let's say you scored the word FRIENDS, and it was also your "Word of the Day" your scorecard would look like this:
