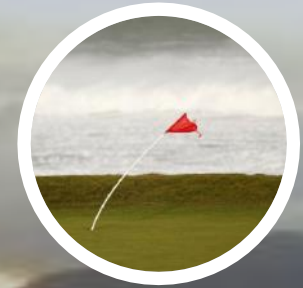
Our Heavenly Father & Chairman

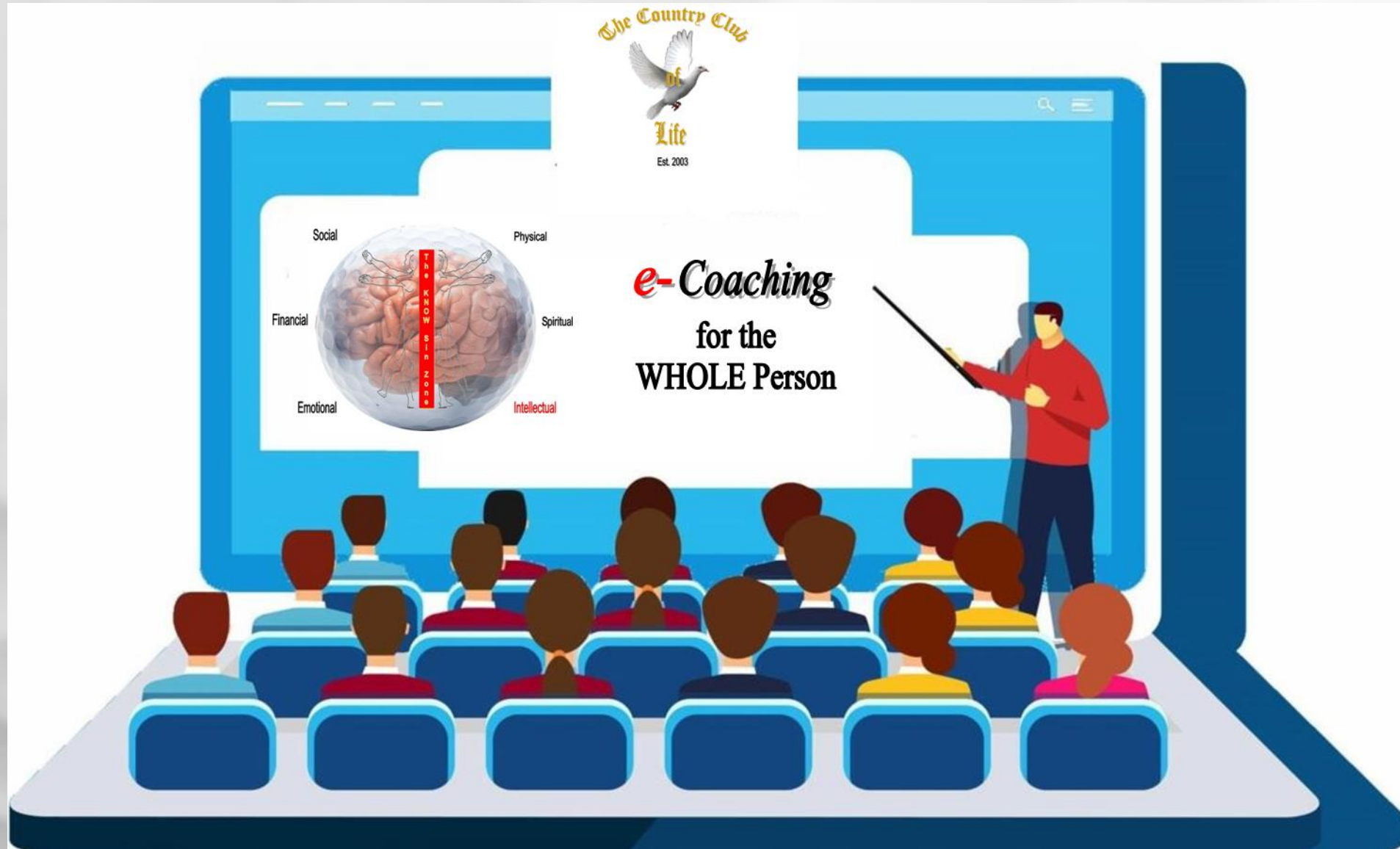

It is suggested this course be played leisurely and wisely to begin shaping and fine-tuning the vital spiritual reflexes of champions. Remember, the sole purpose of this course is to “Shape” the player and keep them focused.

Our Virtual Championship Course requires the player to, “Bring Their Game.” The course is made up of 18 holes over three varying designs as follows; "The Seven Deadlies," "Fruits of the Spirit," and "Victory Corner." These holes are designed as roadmaps to playing the game of life. **Caddies/accountability relationships are a must.** This layout is just too demanding to tackle alone. Design deceptions are far too daunting to play without the assistance of local knowledge, a sound game plan, and strict accountability. Unlike the Beginner/Refresher Course, **"Caddies Are A MUST."**

Ideally, the scorecard is best used in conjunction with the Scoring System weekly when the player and caddie/accountability partner meet.

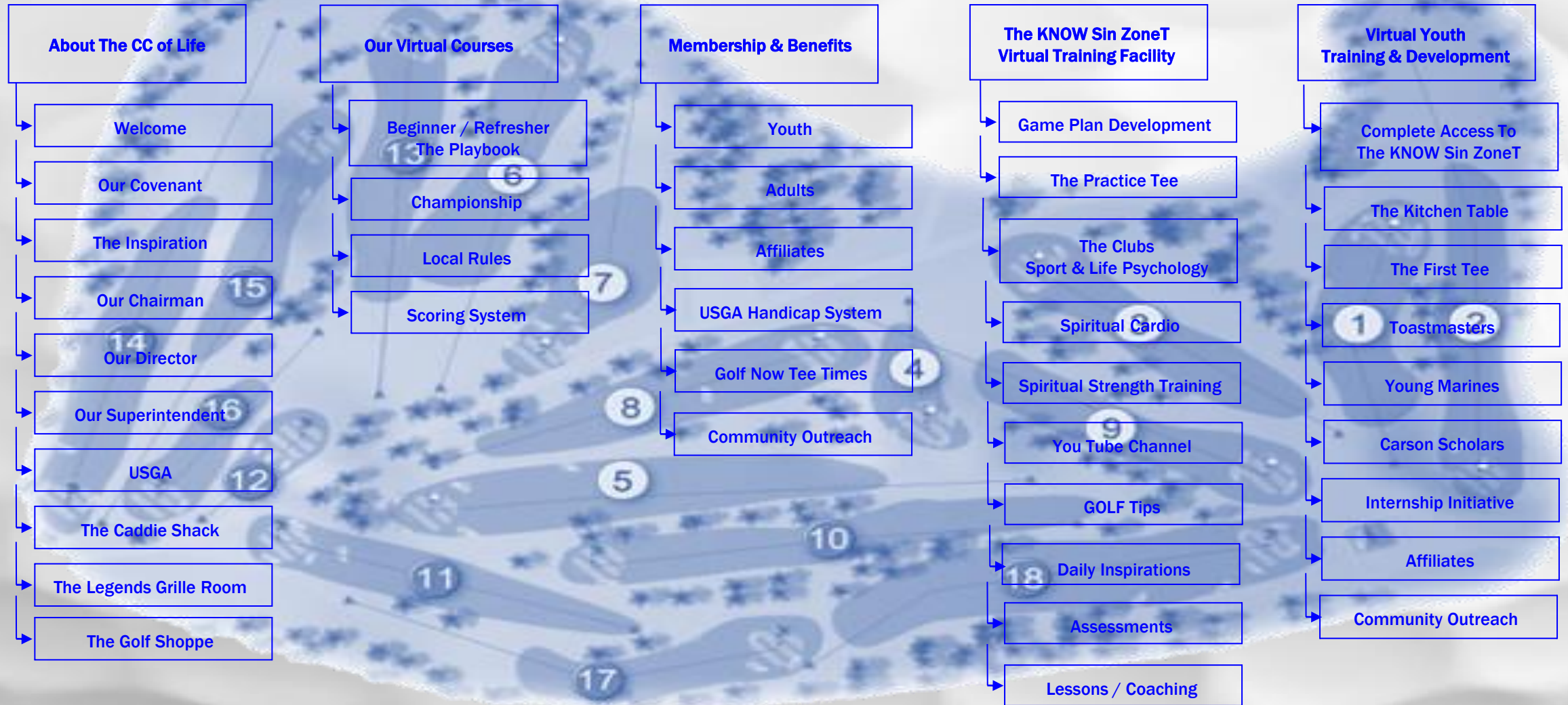

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Choosing a Caddie for Playing the Game of Life

We begin by looking at how to choose our accountability and the need for it. Then we will look at the dilemma of why most of us don't have such a relationship. Finally, we will cover the two "C's" which are the two ingredients of a healthy and prosperous accountability relationship taken from the phenomenal Twelve Steps movement, Confession, Confession, Confession, Conversion and Continuance.

I will guarantee you that Tiger Woods, Jack Nicklaus, Lee Trevino, Sam Snead, Arnold Palmer or any of the greats in the game who played in intense competition day in and day out would not have been nearly as successful and could never have held us under the pressure alone by the mere way of play the game of life in this competitive environment day in and day out by grinding our teeth and letting things churn in our gut? The only things we really accomplish are that our relationships suffer more, or we choose to work harder numbing our feelings even more, or we just do it the old fashioned way and still experience or make hard drug activity.

We're told from when we are young to stand on our own two feet and become independent, aren't we? But the real question, wouldn't you be able to go through life more focused on winning the game and more glorious if you had someone holding you carry you? (It's bigger) that holds you over the head right at the times when you need it most? It's proven that a person is more successful at driving, swimming, doing gymnastics or other substances, if they are accountable to someone else. While there are exceptions to the rule, it's a hard one to argue. The Twelve Step movement which began in the country in the mid 1930's, and has gone on to be the most successful program in the world at bringing people back to life and helping them win the game is only successful with at least one other person.

The same strategy holds true in beginning an accountability relationship. It begins by getting out of your comfort zone. Go to that men's or women's group in your church, go on a retreat weekend, or get out into the Christian community and meet new friends. Challenge the Trinity in the people's lives you meet and see if you get wisdom from them that maybe you don't have before. Or maybe they're just the opposite, and it will be great to get another point of view when sorting through things as you play the game.

Most people who are truly winning at the game of life and enjoying a serene lifestyle, owe their security to the fact that someone took a special interest in them and was willing to share the gift of themselves with them. Accountability with another should be welcomed and accepted as an opportunity to bridge personal insecurities and to design the vulnerability that comes from working with others. There is no better way to experience God's Amazing Grace than through helping others unconditionally.

"Confidence" in Choosing a Caddie

I remember back to my caddying days when the first few times I caddied for a new person, about the only thing I got to do was carry their clubs. In the caddie shack you will be referred to by the more experienced caddies as a "Dink caddie". They rarely asked for savings, and they never asked my opinion on reading a putt. Even though I was a tremendous caddie (the high), I had not earned their confidence.

In any relationship, confidence is critical to its success. Probably the best way to build confidence in any accountability relationship is to share with the other person our experience, strength and hope in life. This is not a one-time relationship. In general, like all of us, we want to be able to play the game of life in this competitive environment day in and day out by grinding our teeth and letting things churn in our gut? The only things we really accomplish are that our relationships suffer more, or we choose to work harder numbing our feelings even more, or we just do it the old fashioned way and still experience or make hard drug activity.

"Confession" in the Player / Caddie Relationship

I must admit that I'm enjoying this opportunity to revisit my caddie days. I'm now reading caddie/player relationships. I began with more new golfers. It wasn't until they had the chance to see me up and I had seen everything about their games over numerous rounds that I gained their confidence, and they would begin asking my opinion on the course. They took their time in asking me up to see what made me tick and I was compatible with them.

As an accountability relationship proceeds by us honestly sharing our experiences, strength, and hope in life, we will begin to get our new friend to begin sharing a bit about themselves as they become more comfortable with us because they've had the opportunity to see us up. Whether it's in a golf cart or on the course, our new friend may begin by only talking to us with his back and then we need to hang in there "a day at a time", patiently allowing them the time they need to develop confidence in the relationship.

The confusion step is not about deep seated sins, but about opening up with someone and allowing that bigger which we all accumulate over time to stop shelling us with guilt, shame, fear, worry, confusion, failure, etc. and to begin lighting the dead things with our caddie in life, which will begin the process of becoming free and the person God created us to be for his glory for as men especially, this is a frightening task. But, if medical analysis are correct, it could be a life-saving step with our longevity. A recent study I read suggested that having a best friend could be a major reason why women continue to outlive men.

Over the next three weeks, I'm going to share with you some real dialogue between a caddie and "their man" which will demonstrate confidence and trust in their relationship.

Golfer: "You played so poorly all day. I think I'm going to go down myself in that lake."

Caddie: "Sir, I don't think you could keep your head down that long."

Golfer: "You've got to be the worst caddie in the world!"

Caddie: "I doubt it, Sir. That would be too much of a consideration."

Golfer: "I'll move heaven and earth to be able to sink 100 on this course."

Caddie: "Oh heaven, Sir. You've already moved most of our earth."

"Conviction" in the Player / Caddie Relationship

The third ingredient of an accountability relationship is conviction. As the confidence levels continue to build and we begin to open up with each other more, we must get honest and begin coming to the end of ourselves in order to experience true growth and have our best best. We must get out of the short view of our life and accept our limitations and admit we are powerless to produce the outcomes in our lives.

This especially holds true for young tour players fresh out of college. When they hit the tour, it's a new ball game. It's a good idea that a new tour player's first caddie is older knowing and accepting their limitations can be the difference between keeping their card and going back to Q School. As young kids we go after the power, as John Daly says, "we let the big dog eat" almost always. We don't allow our team, we try to go through them. We're indestructible...as we think. However, one round with a top player and it doesn't take long for us to become humbled.

Isn't this the same way in life? Many of us have had to have our ways trimmed in order to gain the wisdom we enjoy today. A healthy accountable relationship will help us to see and face who we really are and just how unsuccessful we will be at playing life alone.

If we're honest about ourselves and the other person, there's no limit to when we can become, and the instrument we can be in helping another achieve their eternal potential. We must remember that if there is to be equal opportunity employment and doesn't discriminate between any denomination or religion. So, if a situation seems to be beyond our power, we have the assurance of the good of God that he will equip the called.

A good piece of advice with this phase of the relationship is to keep in mind that honesty without compassion is no more than subtle hostility. Let's return to our friends from last week and watch for us more of the dialogue between them. I think we will see they didn't take this advice.

Golfer: "Do you think I can get there with a 5-iron?"

Caddie: "Eventually."

Golfer: "This is the worst golf course I've ever played on!"

Caddie: "This isn't the golf course, sir. We left that on tour again."

Golfer: "Well, I have never played this badly before."

Caddie: "I don't realize you had played before, sir."

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"Continuance" The "AC" in the Hole

Over the Christmas holiday, it seems that wherever I turned on a news broadcast, one of the questions asked of people being interviewed is, "Have Christmas feel different this year as a result of 9/11?" The answer is a resounding "Yes" across the board. Let's explore why this is and we will then understand why the "Continuance" ingredient is so critical to the accountability relationship.

I am as guilty as anyone of contributing to what is a relationship by being another person for granted, assuming they will always be there for me. However, I have shown myself long and tried again that what I saw out of my own head and reach out to others, I seem to be able to see every day as I'm seeing this. Open to life.

Whether it's on the course or in life, let's join with that person we are accountable to and keep each other mindful of the following...

"There's strong and beautiful flower must have a strong root in the ground. It must and a root down so that it may be rooted and grounded what at the same time it sends a shoot up to be a flower that shall gladden the world. Both growths are necessary. Without a strong root, it would wither. The higher the growth upward, the deeper the roots the rooting." (Taken from the Nicotiana 24 in devotion.)

Our lives cannot flower into variety and helpfulness unless they are rooted in a strong faith. (Our our position as G.O.P.s, that is, faith in Jesus Christ), and we feel deeply secure in the goodness and purpose of God's loving and amazing grace.

The goal for future Christmas seasons should be a different feeling from past seasons not because of circumstances, but because we have entered into an accountability relationship where we abide in Christ daily, thus making our hearts a habitation for the Son of God and experiencing that joyful peace that comes of understanding what a feeling of Christmas, every day of the year through good times and bad. Through a solid accountability relationship as we give in our purpose for God, hopefully our future Christmas days will be filled with a comfortable hope (and know) to prepare our hearts for a feeling of "peace on earth and goodwill to men."

In a historic and far-reaching decision last year, the U.S. Supreme Court officially reversed Roe v. Wade, declaring that the constitutional right to abortion, upheld for nearly a half-century, no longer exists. Writing for the court majority, Justice Samuel Alito said that the 1973 Roe ruling and repeated subsequent high court decisions reaffirming Roe *"must be overruled because they were egregiously wrong, the arguments exceptionally weak and so damaging that they amounted to an abuse of judicial authority."* This decision will mean that the court itself, as well as the abortion question, will become a very large focal point in the upcoming presidential election.

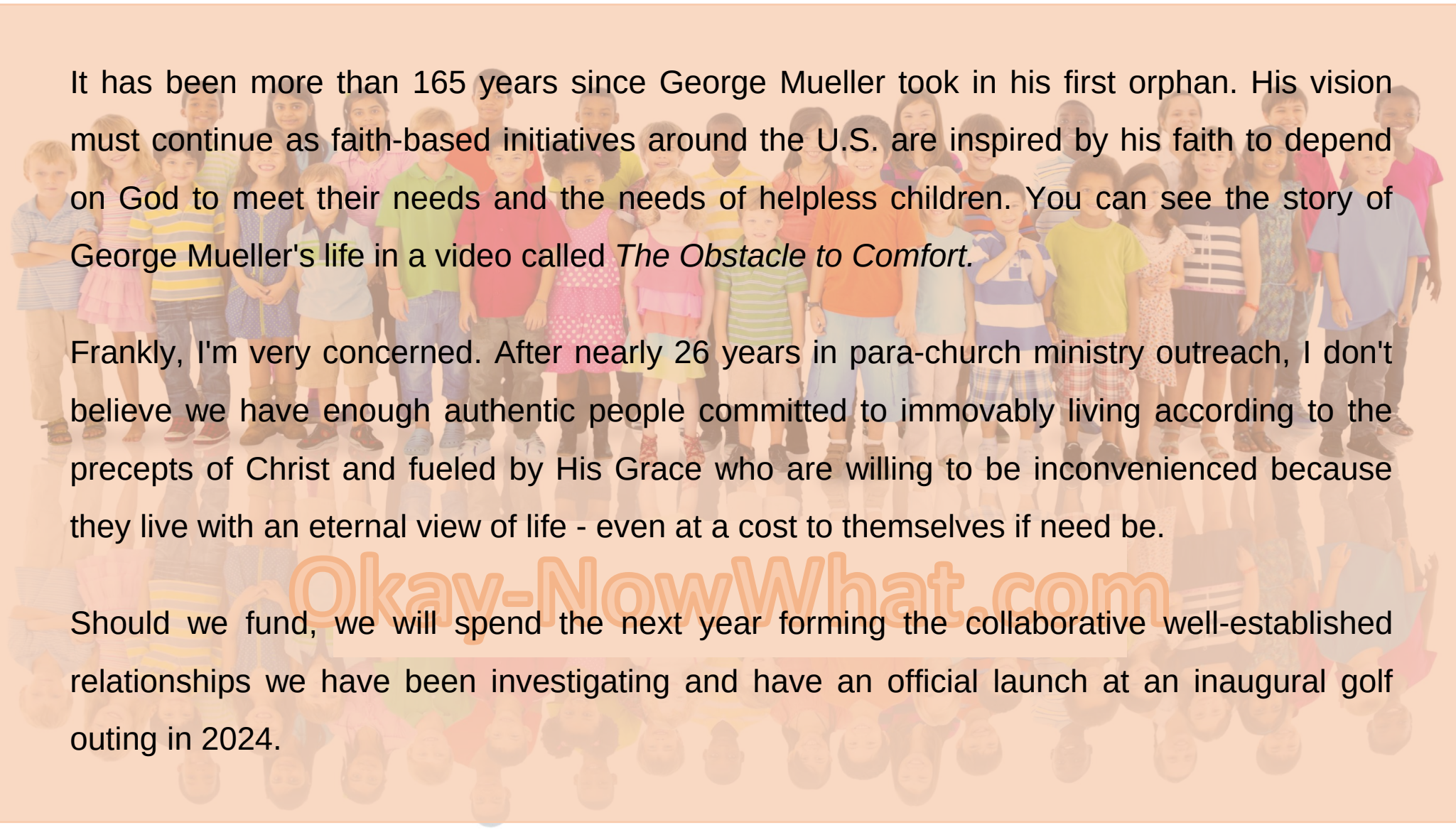
