

# Learning to drive

Since Monday 4th June 2018, learner drivers were able to take driving lessons on motorways in England, Scotland and Wales. This will help to make sure more drivers know how to use motorways safely.

Learner drivers will need to be:

- accompanied by an approved driving instructor
- driving a car fitted with dual controls

Any motorway lessons will be voluntary. It will be up to the driving instructor to decide when the learner driver is competent enough for them.
