

HEATING BOILERS ~ Preventive Maintenance

With the heating season fast approaching, now is probably the best time to start readying your heating boiler(s) for the long winter season. With Low Water Cut-Offs and Furnace Explosions continuing to be the contributing causes of accidents, and, for the most part, being so easily avoidable with a little preventative maintenance, it is probably a good time to go over a template for responsible boiler operation.

Before placing a boiler into service, the entire system should be checked over by certified personnel. At the same time it wouldn't hurt to review the following:

- Operating Manuals and Procedures
- Maintenance During Summer Lay-up
- Start-up Checks after the Summer Lay-up
- Normal Start-up

Now is the best time to do this. Waiting till your boiler is needed is usually a poor time to obtain the services you may need.
