Did vou know? The metaphor of "God's Holy Wings" in Hymn 613 was inspired by scripture passages from Deuteronomy 32: 11, and Psalm 36:7b. Prof. Gracia Grindal used Deut. 34, Psalm 91:4 and Matthew 23: 37 as she translated the first verse of Berg's original hymn and the first couplet of what is now verse 3.
