- Publicize planned events, including through social media platforms, newsletters, newspaper notices, press releases and other promotional materials
- Maintain donor database, and prepare periodic reports to the board regarding donor participation
- Prepare all donor communications, including IRS-required acknowledgements and thank-you letters to donors
- Assist in the identification of grant funding opportunities and preparation of funding requests
- Identify potential corporate sponsors and coordinate funding requests with board members
- Update and maintain SEF website and social media platforms
- Complete all required reporting requirements, including annual corporate reports and tax filings
