The History of the Bethlehem Central High School Womens' Lacrosse Program

The Bethlehem Central High School Girls lacrosse program is marking its 26th anniversary in 2018. The program started in 1992 as a JV team that was funded, in part, with a grant from the Women's Sports Foundation. The program has accomplished a great deal in the last few decades. There were 57 girls on its inaugural squad and they had two wins and four loses that year under head coach Nancy McKenna. IN 1993, 68 girls from grades 8 to 12 fielded Bethlehem's JV and Varsity teams.

In its 26 seasons, the Bethlehem Girls Varsity team has won eight Section II titles, six Regional Championships and was State Class A semi-finalist in 2003 and 2005. The program has developed many exceptional players, a number who have gone on to play in college. The most decorated alumnus is Katie Rowan, two-time U.S. National Team member, and recent inductee in the Bethlehem High School Hall of Fame. Rowan attended Syracuse University and was a three-time first team All-American who led the nation in scoring with 142 points in 2008. Katie is in her third season as head coach of the Wagner Women's Lacrosse team. See the list of Bethlehem Alumni who went on to play in college.
