





# From Apples to Apple Trees





## Which apples may be used to harvest seeds to grow trees?





There are <u>four (4)</u> **apples suggested for growing** in Orangeburg County, South Carolina.

They are: Granny Smith (must have = pollinator)
Gala
Honey Crisp
Pink Lady





#### **How to Obtain the Seeds?**

STEP 1

Purchase apples

STEP 2

Eat the apples and save the seeds

STEP 3

Line a pie pan with paper towel

STEP 4

Label the paper towel with the name of the apple seed being collected


STEP 5

Allow the seeds to dry – <u>Do Not</u> wash

STEP 6

Any sprouts need to be put on a moist paper towel and put in a plastic bag until they can be planted.







#### **How to Plant the Seeds?**

**STEP 1:** 

Use a peat pot

**STEP 2:** 

Soak peat pots in water a few hours or longer

**STEP 3:** 

Fill with potting soil

STEP 4:

Plant 1 apple seed

**STEP 5:** 

Moisten with water

STEP 6:

Write name of Apple on a

Strip made from an

**Index Card** 

















### **How to Care for the planted seeds?**

**STEP 1:** 

Keep moist

**STEP 2:** 

Do NOT allow the soil to get dry

**STEP 3:** 

Make sure the peat pots can drain.

Use gravel or glass marbles to raise off pan

**STEP 4:** 

Keep in the shade, not in direct sun

**STEP 5:** 

Seeds should sprout in about 1 week

STEP 6:

Keep moist.

**STEP 7:** 

Watch the bottom of the pot, when roots begin to appear it is time to put in a larger pot.
