Interpretation of score:

Explanation of Optional Indices results:

- a. 1 – No illegal signs; 2 – 1-5 illegal signs **Note:** signs posted on light poles and at intersections
- b. 1 – No Graffiti **Note:** (Graffiti on bridges at Landings and on the Back of Highway Signs.)
- c. 1 – No abandoned or junk vehicles; 2- 1 abandoned or junk vehicles; 3- 2-3 abandoned or junk vehicles.
- d. 1- No openly stored items; 2- 1-4 openly items that look untidy, cleaned up in an hour with 1-2 people; 3 – Items openly stored that could fill a small shed approximately 8'x10'; 4 - Unkept, piles, materials strewn around property

Note: SC Hwy #4/Neeses Highway has a crew dedicated to cleaning it. They are having to continuously clean the roadway almost weekly. SCDOT is having culverts replaced along the roadway from Neeses to Orangeburg.
