

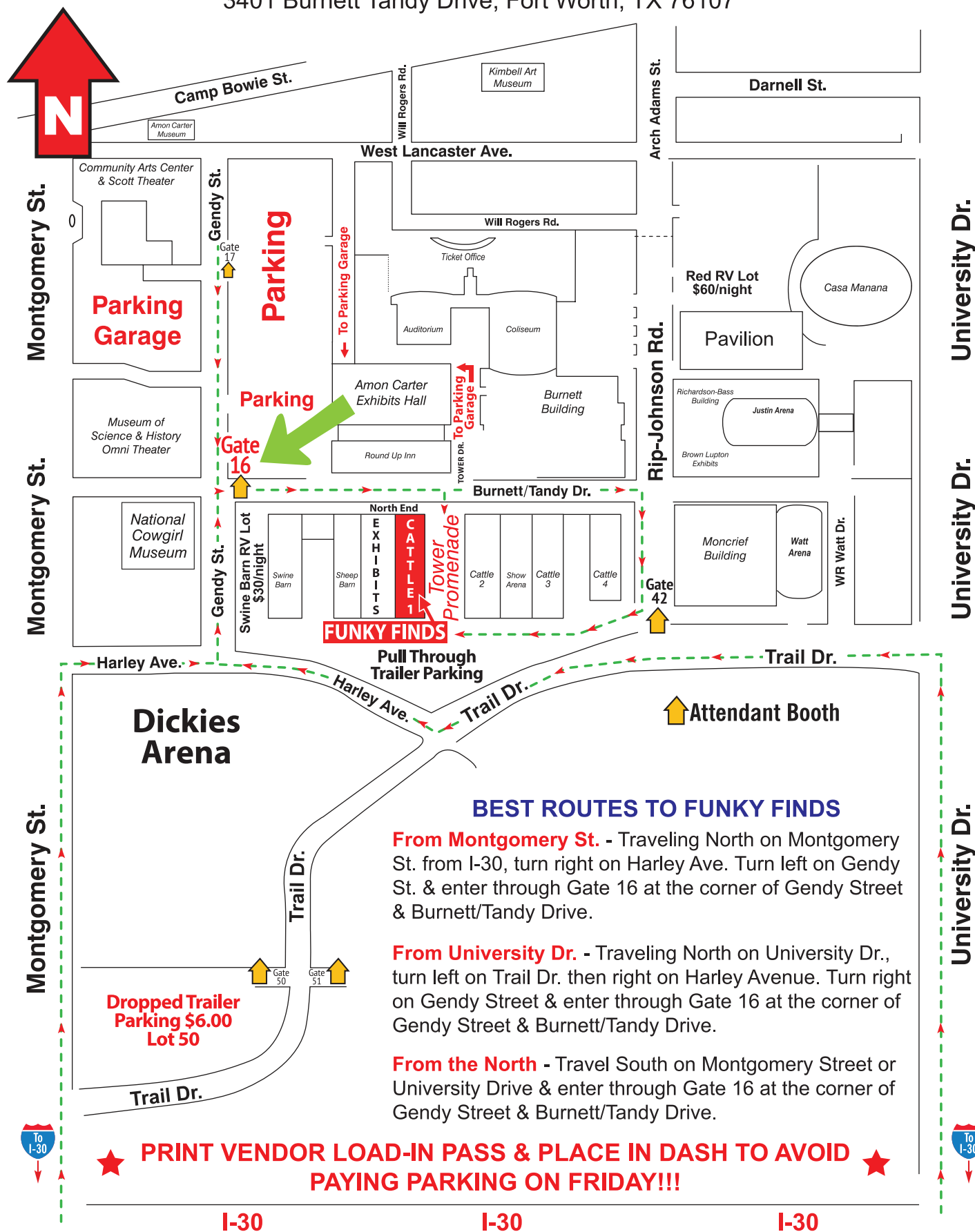

PRINT THE VENDOR LOAD-IN PASS & PLACE IN DASH TO AVOID PAYING PARKING ON FRIDAY!

Parking: On Friday, vendors will be allowed entry to the property free of charge. Please print the attached vendor load-in pass & place in your dash in order to avoid paying parking Friday. Enter through Gate 16 for set-up on Friday. You may enter through any gate on Saturday & Sunday & you will be responsible for parking fees. A parking representative will be selling weekend passes during set-up on Friday. You **MUST** purchase a weekend pass on Friday in order to receive the \$12/day rate; otherwise, you will be charged \$15/day.

The best place to park during the event is in front of the Amon Carter Exhibits Hall or in the underground parking garage. The garage can be accessed from Tower Drive across from the Tower Promenade or off West Lancaster Avenue. Ride the elevator up to ML (Main Level), then exit on Burnett-Tandy Drive.

Check-In: Vendor check in will be located at the raffle area on the North end of the Cattle 1 building (see floor plan map). **ALL VENDORS MUST check in at this location before setting up! Please bring your raffle item (required) & swag bag items (optional) with you to the check in area.**

Unloading: Once you arrive at the facility, please come into Cattle 1 and check in at the raffle area (North end of building - see map below). You will receive your booth assignment and be able to turn in your raffle item (required) and swag items (optional). Then you may unload from Tower Promenade or the South end of the building. Please enter from the North end (from Burnett-Tandy Drive) and exit to the South parking lot. Per fire marshal code, cars are only allowed to be in the Tower Promenade for 15 minutes so it is imperative that you unload your items quickly then park your vehicle in the parking lot BEFORE starting to set up. We are required to hire a security specialist who will be manning the Tower Promenade. Please be respectful and patient. Please note that the North end of the building is a no parking zone (along Burnett/Tandy Drive). We ask that once your vehicle is unloaded that you move your vehicle into a true parking spot. Please be aware that the spaces closest to the South ends of the barns are for Pull-Through Trailers (trucks hooked up to trailers). The Promenade will not be used on Saturday, but will be open again Sunday afternoon for tear down.

Booth Spaces: Will have a label with your business name, booth number, and table & chair amounts at your booth space. Division between booths will be marked with chalk on the ground.

Tables & Chairs: If you ordered tables and/or chairs, they will be in your space when you arrive. **Please DO NOT remove tables or chairs from other booth spaces.** If you decide you need to rent additional tables or chairs, please let a staff member know. Chairs \$5.00, Tables \$14.00 (size 8' x 30") subject to availability. Cash only please.

Electricity: If you ordered power from Edlen Electrical Exhibition Services, be sure to bring some extension cords just in case they are needed. Power must be ordered online at ordering.edlen.com. For assistance, contact Paige Boyd, Office: 682.410.9336, Mobile: 682.244.5139. (This is an external company & Funky Finds does not profit from this in any way.)

Raffle Item: **All vendors are required to donate a raffle item** (as stated in our vendor info). Please turn in item at time of check in - be sure to include a business card attached to your item. If you would like to donate a gift certificate to be redeemed at your booth, that is acceptable, but please make sure it covers the full price of an item (no discounts or requirements to make a purchase).

Internet: Internet access is available through NetSteady for \$25.00/day. To log on, search for the WRMC wireless network on your device. Secure access is available via WRMC-Secure using the encryption code longhorn. You will be given the option to sign up for a WiFi pass or log on for up to 15 minutes per day for free. It is important to log off of the WiFi system if you wish to use your WiFi pass with a different device. On the device you wish to log off, open a web browser & go to <http://logoff.me>. You will be permitted to log on with a different device. Order online at <http://fortworth.netsteady.com> or by phone at 888-295-0567. (This is an external company & Funky Finds does not profit from this in any way.)

RV Spaces: If you need an RV spot during the event, please call 817-991-8497 in advance to check availability. There is a sold out event on property and spaces will be limited. If space is available once you arrive on property, place your RV in that space, then call 817-991-8497 with the lot & space number you are in. Please do not pull into spaces that are blocked by cones. An RV attendant will be sent out to turn on the power, collect your payment, & give you a parking pass (included with rental). ALL SPACES ARE NOW \$70/NIGHT and include 30 or 50 amp hookup, electricity, water and sewer.

Tear Down: **You MAY NOT tear down early for any reason.** When the event ends Sunday at 4pm, the WRMC staff will have already removed the bollards for vehicles to enter the Tower Promenade. Generally it is fast paced activity for the first hour. After about two hours most everyone is packed and headed home. Once the venue is safe for vehicle traffic to enter for loading, the Funky Finds staff will announce that it is safe. Not many are still around to do this but it does help out a few. All vendors & merchandise must be out of the building by 11:59pm Central time on Sunday, March 15th.

Tax ID Permit: Please display a copy of your valid Tax ID permit at the event.

Additional Info: The venue is secured at the end of each day and the perimeter is monitored via on-site security. If you have items that you are uncomfortable leaving overnight, feel free to take those items with you at the end of the day. Funky Finds is not responsible for any loss, theft or destruction of property during event set-up, break-down, or event times.

Funky Bucks: Ten Swag Bags will have a \$10 Funky Bucks gift certificate inside! Recipients can spend these Funky Bucks with any vendor during the Funky Finds Spring Fling on March 14th and 15th, 2026. ***If you make a sale that is paid for with Funky Bucks, write your business name on the back, then turn in at the raffle area & receive cash back from a Funky Finds staff member.** We specify on the gift certificate & in promotion that there is NO cash value & NO refunds. Valid Funky Bucks have a white label on the back with instructions for vendors.

This pass enables you to enter & park at the Will Rogers Memorial Center premises free of charge for vendor setup at the Cattle 1 Building on Friday, March 13th, 2026 (11am-7pm).

Please enter through Gate #16 at the corner of Gendy & Burnett/Tandy Drive for setup.

This pass will need to be shown to the gate attendant when you arrive to setup.

If you leave the property or exit out any gate, you may be required to pay parking on Friday so please be mindful of that.

Parking cashier will be on site Friday selling weekend parking permits. You must purchase a weekend pass to receive the \$12/day rate; otherwise, you will pay \$15/day when you enter the property on Saturday & Sunday.

Please do not leave your vehicle in the unloading area while you set up your booth.

Valid Friday, March 13th, 2026 only.
