- G. As a <u>builder member</u>, I agree to meet or exceed the standards that are established in residential warranty programs through use of no less than one year written warranties. As an <u>associate contractor member</u>, I will honor manufacture's warranty programs and establish a fair exchange policy for items not covered by a manufacturer's warranty.
- H. I agree to abide by the Code of Ethics and the Contractor Quality Commitment Standards to maintain credibility and assure public confidence in the Franklin County Builders Association.
