ORDINANCE NO. 96-/

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE NEW PARIS CONSERVANCY DISTRICT FROM THE OWNERS OF PROPERTY SERVED BY THE DISTRICT'S SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the New Paris Conservancy District has constructed sanitary sewer collection and treatment facilities and in connection therewith on the 26th day of May, 1994 adopted New Paris Conservancy District Ordinance 94-1 whereby an original schedule of rates and charges to be collected by the New Paris Conservancy District was established pursuant to Indiana law; and,

WHEREAS, the original schedule of rates and charges for sewer service provided by the New Paris Conservancy District established a monthly equivalent dwelling unit total charge of \$33.61 per month; and

WHEREAS, the original schedule of rates and charges for sewer service provided by the New Paris Conservancy District and originally contained in Ordinance 94-1 contained an equivalent dwelling unit calculation which included charges for operation, maintenance and replacement as well as a collection system maintenance charge, local capital charge and a billing and collection charge; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the New Paris Conservancy District has received monies from the Build Indiana Fund which will be utilized to pay down the capital charge component of the equivalent dwelling unit calculation; and,

WHEREAS, the resulting reduction in the local capital charge

results in an overall reduction of \$1.01 per month in the equivalent dwelling unit calculation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the New Paris Conservancy District is desirous of "passing through" the resulting decrease in the local capital charge and in so doing reduce the monthly billing for each equivalent dwelling unit by \$1.01 for the customers of the sanitary sewer collection and treatment facilities of the New Paris Conservancy District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS of THE NEW PARIS CONSERVANCY DISTRICT as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 (a) of Ordinance 94-1 should be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) All Class I Users

The sewage rates and charges for the residential class of users shall be determined by equivalent single family dwelling units. Sewage service bills shall be rendered once each month (or a period equalling a month). The schedule on which said rates and charges shall be determined is as follows:

SECTION 2. That Section 3 (b) of Ordinance 94-1 should be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) All Class II Users

The sewage rates and charges for non-residential class users shall be determined by equivalent dwelling units (based on equivalency of a single family dwelling unit). Sewage bills shall be rendered once each month (or a period equalling a month). The schedule on which said rates and charges shall be determined is as follows:

SECTION 3. That all other sections and provisions of Ordinance 94-1 should remain in full force and effect and shall be controlling as to all matters related to the District's schedule of rates and charges for collection of sanitary sewage within the New Paris Conservancy District.

SECTION 4. This ordinance amending Ordinance 94-1 shall be in full force and effect and the new rates and charges contained herein shall be effective as of the Conservancy District sanitary sewer service billing which will be due and owing in January, 1997 and from and after its passage, approval, recording and publication as provided by law.
