- NPCD DISTRICT MAP MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY IS NOW VIEWABLE ON THE GIS WEBSITE
- NO NEW CONNECTIONS
- PUMP PROJECT ALL DONE STILL NEED TO GET LOCKS TO THE OPERATOR.
- WAITING FOR PAPERWORK FROM SELGE TO FINALIZE THE LIFT STATION PROJECT.
- SEWER WAS RAN UNDER THE ROAD BY THE DENTIST OFFICE
- ▶ LARGE SUPPORT FACILITY FOR NIPSCO GOING ON PROPERTY BEHIND DENTIST OFFICE. WILL INCLUDE FOUR BUILDINGS AND A SUBSTATION; MATERIAL PARKING AREA; PARKING LOT. ELKHART COUNTY IS MANDATING NIPSCO TO APPLY FOR REZONING. 58.8 ACRE PARCEL. 1/2 MILE NORTH AND SOUTH. VEHICLE ACCESS FROM CR 142. 200 TO 250 EMPLOYEES ON SITE.
