Wedding Vows, Promises and Legal Declarations



Legal Declarations

The following are examples of legal declarations.

The NAME you use doesn't have to be your full name, it can be just your first name, or simply the name you are known to your guests as, e.g. legal name John, but known as Jack, or legal name Katherine but known as Katie.

This is what you each must say legally...

I, NAME, accept you, NAME, in marriage.

But this can be extended if you wish...

I, NAME, solemnly and sincerely accept you, NAME, in marriage

OR

I, NAME, accept you, NAME, in marriage to be my lawfully wedded wife/husband

OR

I, NAME, accept you NAME, in marriage as my equal partner

OR

In the presence of our family and friends, I, NAME, solemnly and sincerely declare, That I accept you, NAME, in marriage, As my lawfully wedded wife/husband OR As my equal partner

Personal Vows/Promises/Pledges

Most couples choose to say your personal promises (vows) to each other before the legal declarations (when you accept each other in marriage – see above!). You can write your own vows for that really personal touch, but that's definitely not for everyone! Have a look at the examples below as a starting point.

If you can't make up your mind, I can start you off with some of my favourites and we can simply adjust them to suit.

You've got a few options when it comes to saying your vows:

- Memorising them (almost nobody does this, and I wouldn't recommend it!)
- Reading them from a prompt card, which I'll make for you
- Repeating after me, a few words at a time (my most popular option)
- Saying 'I do' after I read each line, or saying 'I do' after the whole vows/promises have been read
- Saying 'we do' together after I've read some collective vows (the best option for very shy couples!)

1.
