This year the League is putting in \$1500 towards the Class Shoot off that is \$300 towards each class, but you need 8 scores posted before the shoot off at Ontario to be eligible. There will be no \$5 Class purse fee this year.

# Year End Banquet

Each shooter needs to have posted at least 9 scores to be eligible for a free
