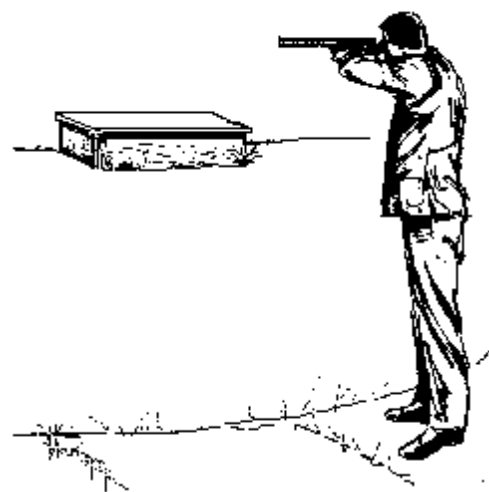


Inland Waters Trap League
