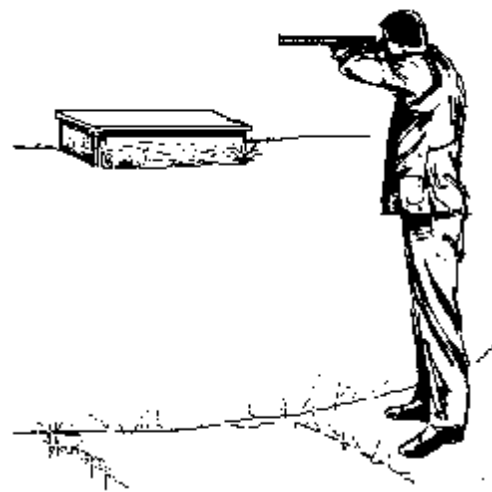


# ***Inland Waters Trap League***
