## ***Qualifications for Shoot off, Banquet, and Awards!!***

### ***Before the Shoot off***

*Each shooter needs to have posted 8 scores **BEFORE THE SHOOTOFF AT ONTARIO**. That means 8 of the first 10 shoots.*

*This year the League is putting in \$1500 towards the Class Shoot off that is \$300 towards each class, but you need 8 scores posted before the shoot off at Ontario to be eligible. There will be no \$5 Class purse fee this year.*

### ***Year End Banquet***

*Each shooter needs to have posted at least 9 scores to be eligible for a free Ticket to the Year End Banquet. (we will still have the \$10 deposit on each of the shooters tickets that will be returned when the shooter shows up at the banquet)*

### ***Awards at the Year End Banquet***

*Each shooter needs to have at least posted 9 scores to be eligible for an Award at the Year End Banquet.*

***Remember this year we have 11 shoots in the league.***
