Qualifications for Shoot off, Banquet, and Awards!!

Shoot off

Only shooters that have posted 8 scores will be eligible for the shoot off at Ontario. This year the League is putting in \$1500 towards the Class Shoot off that is \$300 in each class. There will be no \$5 Class purse fee this year.

Year End Banquet

Each shooter needs to have posted at least 9 scores to be eligible for a free Ticket to the Year End Banquet. (we will still have the \$10 deposit on each of the shooters tickets that will be returned when the shooter shows up at the banquet)

Awards at the Year End Banquet

Each shooter needs to have at least posted 9 scores to be eligible for an Award at the Year End Banquet.

Remember this year we have 11 shoots in the league.
