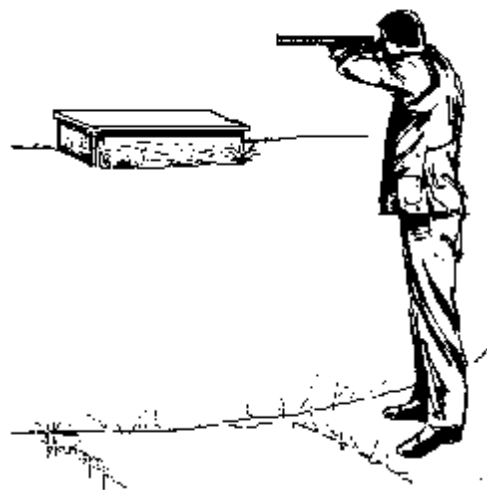


# ***Inland Waters Trap League***

Next Shoot

The 3<sup>rd</sup> shoot of the season is at Mendon Conservation League on October 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. This shoot will also include the Bonbright Event! Bill Kalwas is the Defending Champion. Hope to see you all there.

BONBRIGHT EVENT

The Bonbright event is a 100 bird event that you pay an extra \$15 for. The way it works is that you shoot the full 100 bird event and if you happen to have the highest score of the 100 birds you win the event. Now if you win this year (24-25) you receive an award at the banquet also you need enter the next year (25-26) to defend your title and you will win \$3 per shooter that enters the event in 25-26 year that you shoot better than, the shooters that beat you get a \$3 refund. Example; Bill won the Bonbright last year (23/24) and he received an award at the banquet but no money because he was not the defending champ. Now this year (24/25) if Bill enters again and 30 other shooters enter at \$15 extra and Bill shoots a better score than 25 of the other shooters, Bill will receive \$3 each (\$75 total) from the 25 shooters he beat and the remaining 5 will get a \$3 refund. If Bill does not defend his title the 30 shooters each will get a \$3 refund. If there is a tie for the win the shooters score at the next shoot will count toward for win. If this is still confusing ask a club director.
