Thank you for your travel request. Below are my recommendations based on your travel interests. Let me know if you have any questions or if you want to further outline your next trip.

Option 1 - Panama

This is an 8 hour flight from IND with several 1 stop connections. Most flights are \$350pp (June 8 - 15). A Panama family vacation trip is fun, easy, and won't break the bank. In Panama they speak Spanish but are also highly Americanized due to the large population of expats and the Panama Canal. A few not to miss attractions are the Panama Canal, walking the historical district (Casco Viejo), a Wildlife tour (this is where I saw my first SLOTH in the wild), and visit the many beautiful beaches. Vacation rentals for a 2 bedroom range from \$98/pn and up.

Option 2 - Poconos

This is an all inclusive option where once you arrive you won't have to leave the premises. They have kids activities for all ages posted daily from Scavenger Hunts, Double Dare, Cookout & Carnival, Archery, and much more. 2 or 3 home cooked meals a day. The <u>WOODLOCH</u> is an award winning family run resort for the last 60+ years. Given the price of the all inclusive, in order to fit within your budget, I recommend driving 10 hours to the resort so you have your own vehicle. The lowest resort prices seem to be early June however I would suggest reducing to 5 days from 7 days in order to increase weather temperatures and enjoy the lake options. The other days you can add in stop on the drive home to Hershey, Pennsylvania.

Option 3 - Puerto Rico

This is a very quick flight from IND with quick connections in Miami, CLT, EWR. Most flights are \$300pp. Next I would suggest a stay at the Embassy Suites hotel where kids stay free and includes breakfast and evening happy hour. Large rooms with extra pull out living area will give the family space. Another benefit of this hotel is it is located 5 minutes from the Isla Verde beach where the hotel has a section just for guests with towels, chairs, and umbrellas. One of the most unique recommendations is to see the bioluminescent bay. Bioluminescence season is between July and Sept.
