This letter is to notify you of another "Open House" with evening hours planned for the East Regional Waterline Improvement Project on the following date:

August 30th from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m. at Allen East Schools at 9105 Harding Hwy Harrod, Ohio 45850

There will be representatives available for questions/assistance from the following entities:

USDA will have representatives available to explore eligibility for assistance with service connection costs and tap fees for property owners who meet low-to-very low income standards. Applicants would have to make under:

City of Lima will have a Customer Service representative available to assist with setting up a water account as well as a Field Services representative to answer questions related to the water service line and tap process. Please bring a photo ID as well as check/cash in the amount of \$500 for the tap fee.

Allen County Health Department will have a representative available to answer questions regarding the well permitting process as well as assist in initiating the permit process if homeowners are interested.

Allen Water District will be available to answer questions. Those who reside in the Project Area but outside Village limits will be able to sign up for the water by signing a Connection Agreement. Again, those who sign on in the initial connection period will have their well permit fees up to \$175 covered by the District. The more property owners outside the Villages who sign on, the lower the cost will be for all users. Please bring check/cash in the amount of \$42 for recording fees if interested.

The District still intends to hold a **Project Wrap-Up Meeting** in early fall once construction is substantially complete so final project costs can be presented. You should receive a notice of this meeting by mail. Our website and Facebook page will also be updated. Please feel free to contact our office with any questions. Thank you!
