Trail Report:

Newfield side:

Nature Conservancy—many trees down... can we enter to clear? Can we use the trail for 5 weeks in late Jan-Feb 2026 next year—before logging begins? Didn't log this year. New sign in place showing our trails, major trees down, lots of work, 5 weeks set aside for snowmobiling. Gene will contact John Bailey.

2025-26: Trail work/bridges

Pickett Mountain—we have perennial water holes/rocky mess...

4-5 dump truck loads of 2" rock? (We can cut a few trees to get small dump trucks back in there—cut 8+ trees to straighten a few corners.)

Need to find someone who is willing to drive a truck out there... ground is solid Looking to move the mountain, not really much we can do.

Walker Woods truss bridge—surface ok? (on B loop) May need replacing this fall....22' long or so... *Bob will go look again to see what it needs. Will do a lumber order.*

Consider pingutt gates at crossings where snow melts first-to close just those sections of trail. This could avert overall Trail closings. *Yellow chain would be the best, 1,000ft* \$130-140

Discussed an alternative route around Russ Libby's Field. **Stay in the woods to stay out of the field.**

<u>Limericks side:</u> Has a lot of trail reroutes and keeping a list of what to do.

New reroute quarry rd to Emery corner is approved by landowners and ready for cutting.

A major section of trail was in jeopardy of closing, big thank you to the Carroll family for their continued support and purchasing the land to keep our trail in place.

Gates to close off problem areas instead of closing trails.

Build barricades to possibly put in opened up areas.

Polaris ride command, the trail advisor and will be able to add/delete old or new trails. Map also!

Wood chips, got plenty out back

Winnie rd still needs some attention at the ledges with some equipment.

Business park bridge needs repair

Trailer truck bridge ramp

Dubourdieu Rd bridge needs attention.

Andrews swamp bridge needs taller railings or taller hazard signs.

Keep your eye out for future events/fundraisers: Touch a truck Pop up weekend cookouts anytime Tent at supermarket

Others....

Bob offered to write the Narragansett grant for bridges, culverts, gates, possibly equipment.
