A new sled was talked about and the club would like to upgrade its fleet, selling a few old ones, motion to purchase a new sled by Bob second by Phil all in favor.

Board updates/recommendations (None at this time)

Trail Report: We had snow!

Wayne spoke about some upcoming reroutes and talking to some new land owners about some new trails, trying to get a new trail around doled pond, Emery Corner rd and a few others.

Gates to close off problem areas instead of closing trails. *Plastic yellow chains to help guide in the right direction, better than snow fences will be a new idea to try.*

Build barricades to possibly put in opened up areas. *Mike will try building a few new barricades, Plastic chain may also help in this too.*

Polaris ride command, the trail advisor and will be able to add/delete old or new trails. Map also!

Wood chips, got plenty out back. Will be used on trails.

Newfield side:

Nature Conservancy—many trees down... can we enter to clear? Can we use the trail for 5 weeks in late Jan-Feb 2026 next year—before logging begins? Didn't log this year. Will see if Gene can contact John Bayly to see if we can have a small window of a week of use next season.

2025-26: Trail work/bridges

Pickett Mountain—we have perennial water holes/rocky mess...

4-5 dump truck loads of 2" rock? (We can cut a few trees to get small dump trucks back in there—cut 8+ trees to straighten a few corners.)

Need to find someone who is willing to drive a truck out there... ground is solid.

Bob would like to put some time and material to help with this

Walker Woods truss bridge—surface ok? (on B loop) May need replacing this fall....22' long or so... Bridge is about due for a new one, Bob will look more into this and have further information

Consider pingutt gates at crossings where snow melts first-to close just those sections of trail. This could avert overall Trail closings. **Yellow plastic chain will also help**

Need to pick up trail signs and snow fences and any extra trash!
