Additional qualifications include:

- 1. Resident of Morris County (minimum residence requirement of two years).
- 2. Financial need statement and anticipated tuition cost.

After the initial screening of applicants, the remaining candidates will be interviewed by a team of administrators. The Scholarship Committee will select the finalists for the awards. All high schools forwarding applications will be advised of the final selections. Scholarship funds will be mailed to the scholarship recipient. In the event the recipient does not complete the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded, or does not enter the college stated when the award is given, the funds must be returned by the institution or the recipient to the Morris County Association of Elementary and Middle School Administrators.
