

We are so proud that our member Alice Massa was awarded a Lifetime Achievement Award in the field of Occupational Therapy on Nov 14, 2020. Congratulations Alice!!

We have success to report on the status of our three projects and an additional last minute project. We received donations of supplies and funds on November 21, which was our drop off date at Asbury Church Parking Lot. Here is how things stand at this writing:

- We have approximately four bags of new toys scheduled to be delivered to the United Way the week of December 1st. We have already confirmed this delivery with them.
- We have collected \$400 for Jody's Joy and will be sending a check to My Sister's Place before Christmas.
- We have \$200 to donate to Ijeoma (EJ) for the Nigerian Mission hospital as well as some supplies such as clothes, sunglasses, books and medical supplies. We will continue to collect supplies until EJ is actually able to travel.

In addition to the above, Coralie asked if we could assist with an emergency project for hurricane relief for Honduras ARIC (Aid Restore Improve Honduras) Once again, Zonta collaborated with the United Methodist Women of Asbury church on Black Friday. We loaded multiple sleeping bags, clothes, cans of food, toys, solar-lamps, etc. Gigi has included some photos. I am pleased that we have ended the year so well despite Covid.
