

The Fast Action issue for October 20th was supporting children's affordability for working families (After Hours Child Care Act) Senate number #976 and House number #3639. The Fast Action Friday caucus for October 6th was the Protected Survivors of Domestic Violence and Stalking Act of 2023 Senate bill #321 and house bill #905.
