I am absolutely thrilled to have you here today and make you part of my "Famiglia." Serving you all a small slice of my life growing up in Brooklyn, New York is like being Baptized with Meatballs!

The Dead Husband is a series of two shows that I wrote. WHO STOLE MY DEAD HUSBAND?, being the first in the series, ran for seven years in Portland from 2004-2011. Five years later, the actors decided they needed to do another show together, so I wrote the sequel, WHY CAN'T YOU STAY DEAD?.

The concept of the Dead Husband comes from an actual event in my life that I managed to turn into comedy. The set and music are very specific to my life experiences growing up. It's sort of a re-creation of actual places and events. It's a tribute to my father and my family.

My father was an accordion player and entertainer in New York and I look back fondly at those summer nights when my father would go into the backyard, take out his accordion and start to play. Then the whole family would join in with song and celebration.

This show is about reconciliation. No matter how crazy things got in the family something always pulled us back together. Maybe it was the music, the food, or the love of family, but in the end we always came back together as family. La Famiglia!

It's "Macaroni every Sunday" which makes me so predictable but easy to find.

Blessed by the love of my wife and partner, Melinda, I hope you enjoy the show. I wish you many blessings along the way! Now, raise your glass!
