Giulio Brouzet has been playing and collaborating with musicians from the Chicago blues scene for quite some time now and his music embodies his love for Chicago blues, New Orleans music, Jazz, Cajun, Americana, folk, and oldies.

With the help of his beloved chromatic, diatonic, bass or special tunings harmonicas, he is a proficient music reader and session musician. Giulio has recorded for countless artists, commercials, and software houses, and has released four CDs under his own name.

He is currently active in Chicago, performing both as a sideman and as a one-man band with guitar, kazoo, nose flute, and foot percussion.

Originally from Italy, Giulio inherited—like so many others—his love for music from his parents and their generous record collection. That long journey led him to choose the harmonica as his main instrument because he thought it was... the coolest one!

He has been performing for over 30 years on streets, rooftops, wagons, trains, clubs, theatres, churches, and festivals all over Europe, with jazz orchestras, small ensembles, and blues bands. He has also worked in drama, free-form performance improvisation, ethnomusicology research, and music therapy.

Giulio holds a Bachelor's degree in Jazz and another in Music Therapy.

He has started and led many harmonica classes, including one at the G. Verdi Conservatory in Milan for 12 years, and another in Milan's main jail, teaching inmates the rudiments of the blues and train syncopation.
