

## Printingmaking-Create Symmetrical Images

1) Fold the paper in 1/2.






2) Draw 1/2 of a butterfly with paint. Half a butterfly looks a little like the letter 'B'.



Add different kinds of lines & shapes to make design interesting. Look at real butterflies, or photos, examples of art and elements of art to get more ideas.



\* Drawing a pencil border around outside edge, before applying paint, will help prevent paint from oozing out when pressing in Step 3). Erase when dry.

## 3) Fold again & press gently all around the paper. Open & let dry.







4) Have fun; color.



All the examples are the same "style", by the same artist, me. Don't copy. Create your own stlye. Use your imagination.
