


In my trusty mail truck, I will deliver without fail.**




**Hey Boo. What will you do?

I will tow it to the garage in my sturdy tow truck.**




**Hey Boo. What will you do?

I will deliver them, safe and sound, to the new car dealership.**


**Hey Boo. What will you do?**
