

Hey Boo. What will you do?


What will I do? It's a beautiful day! With my trucks, I will play.








What will I do? I will leave letters and packages and all of your mail. In my trusty mail truck, I will deliver without fail.




What will I do? I will gather garbage to keep the city clean and clear.


My garbage truck is big and loud, you'll hear when it is near.




In my snow plow, I will remove the snow. There is no need to worry.




What will I do? In my dump truck, I will haul a heavy load. I will drive it very carefully and dump it down the road.








Hey Boo. What will you do?

For safety, siren sounding, I will speed at a fast pace.




I will drop them off with my delivery truck, door to door.












To the saw mill, I will take them, where they are cut for lumber.
