DECORATING GUIDELINES

Item Type:

- Trees are 4 to 7.5 feet tall. Narrow trees are better. Must be artificial with winged tree branches and non-flammable.
- Wreaths are at least 24" in diameter. Must be artificial and non-flammable.

Accessories, Decorations and Assembly:

- All accessories and decorations **must be WIRED or GLUED to the tree**, tree skirt, wreath or centerpiece.
- Tree sections must be screwed together. They should not separate during the moving process.
- **Lights must be NEW and in working order.**
- Ornaments and decorations must be artificial and **non-glass**.
- All trees must have a skirt or drape.
- All trees must be supported by a tree stand.
- All accessories under the tree will be sold with the tree. They must be wired to the tree or tree skirt. It is recommended that under the tree accessories be limited.
- Wreaths must be ready to hang.

DATES TO REMEMBER

- Items must be delivered to the Overland Park Convention Center by the donor on Tuesday, November 16, 2021. Display dates and Silent Auction are November 18-21, 2021, at the Holiday Boutique at Overland Park Convention Center.
