

### Mexico Parental Alienation Law

Art. 1. This Law provides for parental alienation.

Art. 2. An act of parental alienation is considered to be interference in the psychological formation of the child or adolescent promoted or induced by one of the parents, by the grandparents or by those who have the child or adolescent under their authority, custody or surveillance to repudiate the parent or that causes damage to the establishment or maintenance of links with it.

Single paragraph. Exemplary forms of parental alienation, in addition to the acts thus declared by the judge or found by expert examination, performed directly or with the help of third parties:

- I carry out a campaign to disqualify the parent's conduct in the exercise of paternity or maternity;
- II hinder the exercise of parental authority;
- III hinder contact of a child or adolescent with a parent; IV hinder the exercise of the regulated right to family life;

Countries like BRAZIL, MEXICO AND ROMANIA have passed a law making Parental Alienation into a criminal offence

Parental Alienation - Brainwashing a child to hate a parent

### About Parental Alienation

The parental alienation is a disorder that arises primarily in the context of childcustody disputes. Its primary manifestation is the child's campaign of denigration against a parent, a campaign that has no justification. It results from the combination of a programming (brainwashing) parents indoctrinations and the child's own contributions to the vilification of the target parent. The alienation usually extends to the non-custodial parent's family and friends as well.

Many children involved in divorce and custody litigation undergo thought reform or mild brainwashing by their parents. This disturbing fact is a product of the nature of divorce and the disintegration of the spousal relationship in our culture. Inevitably, children receive subtly transmitted messages that both parents have serious criticisms of each other.

Parental Alienation, however, is much more serious. It involves the systematic vilification by one parent of the other parent and brainwashing of the child, with the intent of alienating the child from the other parent

### **Excerpt from Chapter 13**

Regarding custody and parenting time, the proceedings of the European Court of Human Rights are mostly based upon the following articles of the European Convention on Human Rights:

Article 6 - Right to a fair trial

1. In the determination of his civil rights and obligations or of any criminal charge against him, everyone is entitled to a fair and public hearing within a reasonable time by an independent and impartial tribunal established by law. Judgment shall be pronounced publicly but the press and public may be excluded from all or part of the trial in the interests of morals, public order or national security in a democratic society, where the interests of juveniles or the protection of the private life of the parties so require, or to the extent strictly necessary in the opinion of the court in special circumstances where publicity would prejudice the interests of justice.

Article 8 - Right to respect for private and family life

- 1. Everyone has the right to respect for his private and family life, his home and his correspondence.
- 2. There shall be no interference by a public authority with the exercise of this right except such as is in accordance with the law and is necessary in a democratic society in the interests of national security, public safety or the economic well-being of the country, for the prevention of disorder or crime, for the protection of health or morals,

Article 6 is the article most frequently cited, especially regarding the length of proceedings. It is crucial in family matters because, as the Court reiterates time and again, the excessive length of proceedings can predetermine their outcome, with "alienation" progressing in time

### QUESTIONNAIRE

The Adverse Childhood Experience (ACE) questionnaire is a 10 item survey that individuals fill out. Every item that applies to the individual is translated into **ONE** point.

At the end of the survey, the points are calculated and the ACE score is given.

### **ACE SCORE**

The ACE Score is a tally of different types of abuse, neglect, and other hallmarks of a rough childhood. According to





### **OPTIONS:**

Order for increase in parenting time with the targeted parent

Record the finding & send alienating parent for education by a parenting coach / expert / psychologist

Order for child to be taken to child psychologist to determine true & uninfluenced voice of the child


Ignore it, since tutoring / brainwashing is normal part of divorce

Order a strictly enforced parenting plan with monthly monitoring

In case of repeated findings of tutoring / alienation, shift the custody of the child to targeted parent

it would suffice to say that increasing parenting time in order to facilitate de-alienation, psychological evaluation of alienating parent, strictly monitored parenting plan and shift of custody are all appropriate responses depending on stage & extent of alienation.

The judge asked my spouse / spouse's lawyer to refrain


The judge asked me to be a better parent & win the trust of the child

### Impact of judicial response on alienating parent



### **OPTIONS:**

No

Yes, there was distinct improvement for a few weeks / months, but after that it was same as before

Yes, there is distinct improvement

In fact, lack of judicial response results in emboldening the alienating parent and legitimises the lies and manipulation in the mind of the child, thereby abetting child abuse.

Involving a child in parental dispute or expecting the child to respond meaningfully or appreciate the consequences of his or her responses not only defies common sense but is also strongly discouraged by child psychologists.








They suffered loss of parental assurance, fear of death of one of their parent and extreme anxiety from lack of information about well-being of their parent.
