

KOSTANTINOS SOVARAS

Kostantinos has been a member of the Nassau County Police Veterans Association since its inception and presently holds the position of Member Liaison on the Executive Board.

Kostantinos has served in the military for over 23 years. He enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 2001 and served in the Marine Corps

Reserve until 2012. Throughout his service, he was deployed to the Middle East in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom. Following his discharge from the Marine Corps, he joined the United States Air Force Reserve in 2013. In 2016, he transitioned to the Air National Guard and is currently assigned to the 106th Rescue Wing, Francis S. Gabreski ANG Westhampton Beach, New York. Recently, he was deployed to the Middle East in support of Operation Inherent Resolve and was previously deployed to East Africa in Support of Counterterrorism Operations. Additionally, he was deployed in support of humanitarian efforts during Operation Allies Refuge.

Kostantinos has served in both Federal and Local Law Enforcement for over 15 years. He began his career in Federal Law Enforcement in 2009 as an Immigration Enforcement Agent with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). His assignments included the Washington D.C. Field Office and the New York Field Office, where he was assigned to various units and was a Firearms Instructor. He also briefly served as a Federal Air Marshal with the Federal Air Marshals Service (FAMS) Washington Field Office.

Kostantinos joined the Nassau County Police Department in 2014. His assignments included the Fourth Precinct, Community Oriented Police Enforcement (COPE), and the First Precinct. He is currently assigned to the Patrol Division in the First Precinct.



NASSAU COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT PBA PRESIDENT

THOMAS SHEVLIN

Tommy Shevlin is the President of the Nassau County PBA, the largest law enforcement union in Nassau County. Tommy has become a recognizable figure in organized labor, and is respected by his peers, members, elected officials and the public alike.

Tommy is very honored to be Nassau County Police Veterans Law Enforcement Person of the Year. NPVA

President Matt Schmidt, NPVA board, and their members, are exemplary men and woman. Tommy is grateful for their military and police service.

Tommy was inspired to become a police officer by father, also Thomas, a NYPD Homicide Detective, who also served in the United States Navy. On August 31, 1998, Tommy followed in his father's footsteps and took the sacred oath to become a NYPD officer. He worked in the NYPD on patrol and as an undercover officer until November 1, 2005, when he was appointed by the Nassau County Police Department. Tommy worked in the 3rd precinct on patrol for 12 years. While in the 3rd Pct. Tommy was also elected as a PBA delegate speaking on behalf of 200 cops. In this position, he witnessed the unmet needs of his fellow officers.

Tommy requested and was reassigned to the Employee Assistance Office, where he worked as a counselor to help his brother and sisters in blue. Tommy's goal is to break the long-standing fear and stigma, which has prevented first responders from getting help.

After counseling and helping cops and their families for over 4 years, Tommy considered how he could assist officers in a more global way. Tommy's love for his brothers and sisters in blue led him to run for Nassau County PBA president.

On January 1, 2021, Tommy started his four-year term as the Nassau County PBA President. Being a union leader has its challenges. While performing his daily duties, Tommy maintains his passion for mental health and helping cops, military personnel and their families. He is focused on policies that enable and encourage law enforcement officers to receive support.

As PBA President, Tommy has implemented a program to send PBA baskets to members who have been deployed. These baskets are filled with snacks from home. He knows the importance of letting his members who are serving away from home know they are not forgotten. Tommy was also instrumental in assigning a military PBA liaison, so that the needs of this special population continue to be met. At the May 2024 PBA Top Cop Event, Tommy welcomed home and gave special recognition to those police officers who are in the United States Military. Additionally, the PBA, under Tommy's Leadership fought to protect the rights of our law enforcement/ military members' July 4th benefit.

Tommy and this PBA will continue to support, fight for, and safeguard the rights of those distinguished officers, who not only protect and serve our Nassau County community, but who also protect and serve our great country in the United States Military.



Wantagh Chamber of Commerce President CATHY MCGRORY POWELL

Wantagh Chamber of Commerce President, Cathy McGrory Powell, is so very honored to be recognized by the Nassau Police Veterans Association, as their work is so very important to all who serve and protect.

Cathy taught junior high school social studies in Valley Stream for seven years, where she was awarded "Teacher of the Year," by the administration. In 2000,

Cathy elected to retire from teaching to raise her three children and help her husband Bill expand the family business.

Cathy, Bill and their children Brian, Valerie and Michael, have called Wantagh home for over 29 years. During this time, Cathy was Chairperson of the Long Island Planning Council where she established Heroes' Walk, which is a September 11th Memorial in Wantagh. Cathy also held the position of Co-President of the Wantagh Sport Booster Club for three years and was a member of the Wantagh School District 6-12 Association. Cathy has also volunteered for Project Thank a Cop's hospitality station.

Cathy mixed two of her passions, helping Veterans and rescuing dogs, to hold a fundraiser that benefited Pets4Vets and Furbabies Rescue. It was this action and other charitable work that Cathy had done that enabled her to be selected for the Town of Hempstead's Pathfinder Award for Humanitarianism. Recipients of this award are selected for demonstrating their exceptional commitment to their community. Cathy has also been recognized by the Woman of Wantagh Committee as well as by the Town of Hempstead and Nassau County for her dedication to the Community and Wantagh Chamber of Commerce. In 2023, Senator Steve Rhoads, honored Cathy with the Women of Distinction Award, where she was recognized as a visionary leader.

Cathy took on the role of President of the Wantagh Chamber of Commerce in 2019 and is presently still in that role. That same year, Cathy was named the Herald/Citizen's "Person of the Year." Cathy and her team of Board members established the first Wantagh St. Patrick's Day Parade, which quickly became the largest St. Patrick's Day Parade on Long Island and is attended by tens of thousands of parade goers. The Chamber holds many events in addition to the Parade, such as the annual Winter Wonderland, that promotes the town and businesses of Wantagh and has become community and family traditions.

VETERAN HIGHLIGHT SGT. BENJAMIN GEREMIA

Benjamin Geremia, 101 years of age, enlisted in the United States Army at Camp Upton, Yaphank, NY on May 23, 1944. Benjamin completed his basic training in Fort Benning, Georgia and proudly served from 1944 to1946. He was activated for duties in WW2 with the 4th Infantry Division (IVY) and eventually reached the rank of Sergeant.

Benjamin is a Purple Heart recipient due to being wounded in the Battle of Hurtgen Forest on Dec 5th,1944 by mine shrapnel and a 30 caliber machine gun bullet to the leg.



Benjamin and his beautiful wife, Beatrice, who turns 97 years young next month, will celebrate their 77th wedding anniversary this November.

Together, Benjamin and Beatrice were blessed with two children, Joann and Robert, 5 grandchildren and 7 great


grandchildren with another one due this December!




