

FAQs

Q: What is included in my order?

A: Your order includes the set of 10 designer nails, a cuticle pusher, an alcohol prep pad, a nail file, an instruction pamphlet, and a tube of nail glue

Q: Will my nails look like the photo?

A: The nails you order will be the ones shown in the photo. All nails are hand painted and unique, once a set is purchased similar ones may be available, but they will not be exactly the same.

Q: Are different shapes available?

A: We encourage following the website as new shapes and styles will be added regularly!

Q: Will replacement nails be available if I lose one?

A: Replacement nails may be available for purchase, however due to the hand painted nature of the product they may not match the remaining nails exactly.

Q: How long will my nails stay on?

A: The glue generally lasts 2 weeks. It ultimately depends on the care you take during the initial application and preparation of your natural nails.

Q: Are my nails reusable?

A: Yes! Your nails are reusable. Use a nail file or buffer to gently remove the old glue from the bottom of your press on nails, remove the glue from your natural nails, and follow the original direction for applying the nails.

Q: How do I remove my nails?

A: Soak your hands in warm, soapy water for 15 minutes. The nails should start to loosen, then you can use the cuticle pusher to gently work under the press on nail slowly removing it from your natural nail. Gently remove the glue from your nails with a nail file. Make sure you dry your nails before storing them.

Q: How can I get the longest life from my nails?

- 1: Avoid getting your nails wet for at least two hours after application!
- 2: Use gloves when using household cleaning products or doing dishes.
- 3: Do not trim or cut the press on nails. This will damage the top coat and cause chips.
- 4: Try to avoid hot baths or wear gloves while in the tub. Exposure to hot water can weaken the glue.
- 5: Avoid using cuticle oils until at least two hours after application as it could weaken the bond between your natural nail and the press on nail.
- 6: Do not use your nails to open packages, cans, or jars.
- 7: Use alcohol wipes to restore shine to your nails.
- 8: Use the provided case to store your nails when not in use.

How to apply your nails:

- 1- wash and dry your hand thoroughly, taking care to remove any oil or dirt from your natural nails and cuticles.
- 2- Push back your cuticles with the provided pusher, make sure you avoid touching the nail surface to prevent natural oils from your skin to get on the nail surface.
- 3- Gently buff the surface of your nails with the file/buffer provided.
- 4- **IF NEEDED** gently shape the base of your nail to fit your cuticle with the file. Skip this step if not necessary.
- 5- Apply nail glue to your natural nail, place the press on nail just under the edge of your cuticle.
- 6- Press and hold the nail in place for at least 30 seconds.
- 7- **Avoid getting your nails wet for at least two hours!**
