REP. MICHAEL GUEST REQUESTS MORE IMMIGRATION, JAMES TULP RESPONDS

Representative Michael Guest signed a letter on Monday urging the Department of Homeland Security to drastically increase the amount of H-2B non-agricultural work visas given out this year. The current cap is 66,000. The letter requests DHS increases that cap by 64,716.

Challenger James Tulp responded by saying, “Imagine being an American college kid with \$50k in student loan debt looking for a summer job. Our congressman wants it to be twice as hard for you.”

James Tulp is running on an America First platform, which includes restricting legal immigration to protect American jobs and wages. A 2018 Harvard-Harris poll found that 81% of all voters support reducing immigration levels.

“Anytime you have more of something, the value of it drops.” Said Tulp. “This of course applies to labor as well. When Michael Guest calls for more immigration, he’s calling for American wages to decline.”

James Tulp has said that the marriage between some in the GOP and corporate America has not worked out well for blue-collar, working class American citizens.

“Cheap foreign labor is great for Wall Street, but horrible for Main Street. I’m running to represent the interests of citizens, not the elite power brokers in Washington.”

James Tulp is running in the Republican Primary for U.S. House of Representatives, Mississippi District 3.
