MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 13, 2019

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at approximately 10:00 a.m. by the LEPC Chairman Patrick Lewis. Those in attendance introduced themselves.

II. ATTENDANCE:

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Minutes from the August 9, 2019 meeting was distributed to attendees for review. Vice Chairman Daugherty asked if there were any revisions the minutes, and none were provided. A motion was made by Walt Daugherty to accept the August meeting minutes as written; the motion was seconded by William Johnston. Motion was approved.

V. FINANCIAL REPORT:

John Hageman reported on the financial statement he created using a bank statement ending August 24, 2019. To summarize activity, there was \$57 in interest income, otherwise no other activity in the accounts since the last report. The current balance was \$57,980.38.

VI. PRESENTATIONS:

Scott Bunning, representative from PEAC Aristatek, gave a presentation. He showed how the PEAC Worst-Case Analysis Service works and talked about how it can help with emergency planning and response. His contact information is: scott.bunning@aristatek.com and (307) 721-2126.

Chris Stokes, SAOEM, provided a presentation on a web app: AACOG Emergency Response Tool. It contains data from 13 counties around Bexar county. He demonstrated the Situation Awareness and Emergency Response Guide tools.

VII. OLD BUSINESS:

Brief LEPC Trailer discussion. Chairman Lewis noted that permission has been granted to sell the trailer, and we will gather all the required documentation to move forward with that.

VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

a. HazMat Watchdog Committee:

William Johnston, BCOEM, reported on the hazmat calls that the county received. He noted that there were approximately 3 calls last month. One call was for an acid spill at the county jail and one person was transported to emergency room. A contractor was working on the water treatment of the jail. Another call was in Hondo at CPS court where some hand delivered letters caused concern, but nothing was found.

Michael Wagner, SAFD Hazmat, advised that there was a regional response with Boerne. Other runs will be reported during next month's meeting.

Patrick Lewis reported on calls that GuadaComa received. A crane caught fire on I-35 and hydraulic fluid leaked out on to the highway. Clean-up was turned over to NRC (formerly SWS).

Willie Davis, HEB, advised on a small ammonia leak with evacuation and no injuries. HEB's hazmat crew took care of response.

CPS advised on a reportable mineral oil spills. One was 254-gallons without PCBs, and a second was 650-gallons spill caused by vandalism that did have PCBs that required a great deal of remediation and asphalt removal.

b. Training Committee:

Patrick Lewis reminded the committee that HOTZONE is October 17-21, 2019. You can find more information at: hotzone.org. About 6-7 partial scholarships awarded, and 2 full scholarships awarded by LEPC.

Cumorah Eldredge advised that its THIRA time again and that all submissions for a grant must fill out a cyber assessment. You will receive a detailed email about it.

William Johnston will give a presentation during next month's meeting on the regional hazmat challenge that is being planned.
