MINUTES FOR AUGUST 10, 2018

SWRI LIBRARY - 6220 CULEBRA ROAD SAN ANTONIO, TX 78238

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at approximately 10:10 a.m. by the LEPC Chairman Hal Lovejoy. Those in attendance introduced themselves.

II. ATTENDANCE:

III. CITIZENS TO BE HEARD:

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Minutes of the July 13, 2018 meeting was distributed to attendees for review. Chairman Lovejoy asked if there were any revisions to the minutes, and one correction was provided. A motion was made by Walt Daugherty to accept July meeting's minutes as written with minor correction; the motion was seconded by Mike Broeker. Motion was approved.

V. FINANCIAL REPORT:

John Hageman reported on the financial statement he created using a bank statement ending July 24, 2018. A copy of the full financial report was emailed out and is attached. To summarize, there was approximately \$34 in interest/dividends income; no contributions made; and no checks written. The current balance as of July 24, 2018 was \$54,624.24.

John Hageman advised that he's working on getting a grant from HEB. It's an online process and John submitted the required information yesterday. He's not sure at this point if it was successful. The grant is for \$1,500. John thanked Willie Davis for making the grant opportunity possible.

Randy Grimes announced that Koch Industries will be contributing \$3,000 to the Bexar LEPC.

VI. OLD BUSINESS:

Walt Daugherty noted that last year through the TCEQ grant a trailer was purchased, and not much has been done with it. He would like to get a committee together to establish graphics, permissions, etc. for the trailer. Walt made a motion to create a committee, but after some discussion, the motion was amended. Walt's amended motion was to create a subcommittee under the community outreach committee to work on trailer details. The amended motion was seconded by John Hageman, and then approved by vote. Chairman Lovejoy advised on the trailer's intended use and described its current status, and then asked for volunteers to be on the subcommittee.

VII. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

a. <u>HazMat Watchdog Committee:</u> (Mike Parsons, William Johnston, Patrick Lewis, Emily Thompson, Ronnie Hernandez)

William Johnston, BCOEM, advised on an animal hoarding case in Medina County that they assisted with. The concern was ammonia levels in the house. Bexar County provided PPE and conducted air monitoring in the house.

Glenn Frost, SAFD Hazmat, provided a brief rundown of various HazMat incidents that were responded to since the last meeting. Approximately 9 were related to high speed/18-wheeler accidents with fuel spills. One notable incident was related to CO at Alamo Downs.

b. Training Committee: (Walt Daugherty, Patrick Lewis, William Johnston, Rick Wall)

Walt Daugherty advised that Rick Wall, who volunteered to oversee the BexarMetro 911 funding, has retired from Helotes FD. Walt will look into the status of the program and training paperwork, and confirm that Bexar Metro 911 gets required paperwork by September.

Chairman Lovejoy reminded everyone that the HOTZONE conference is October 18-21, 2018.
