Minutes for January 9, 2015

OPENING:

I. Call to Order:

Mike Parsons, SAFD Hazmat, noted that there had been a couple carbon monoxide runs since last meeting. There was also a chlorine run called in for the HEB warehouse area, which was cancelled right away. Willie Davis, HEB, commented that there is not chlorine there.

On December 20, 2014 there was a truck carrying HCl that was rear-ended. About 25-gallons of product was lost out of the top manway.

On December 27, 2014 a truck turned over at Loop 1604 and Lookout Road. About 75-gallons of diesel were lost out of the saddle tank.

On January 8, 2014 Drano was found spilled in an apartment.

Mike Parson advised that venue monitoring was done for the military's Exodus at the San Antonio Airport on December 19th & 20th, 2014. Monitoring was also done at the Alamo Bowl and the All-American Bowl on January 2nd & 3rd, 2015. There were no reported incidents at the events.

Patrick Lewis submitted reimbursement information to the LEPC for the 2014 HotZone Conference. This year was not as well attended as before. The reimbursement amount is \$3,221.76 for six responders to attend the conference.
