Minutes for June 12, 2015

OPENING:

I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at approximately 10:05 a.m. by the LEPC Chair Harold Lovejoy. Those in attendance introduced themselves.

Walt Daugherty made a motion to accept the May 8, 2015 minutes as written; the motion was seconded by Mike Parsons. Motion was approved.

V. Financial Report:

Harold Lovejoy provided the information on the financial statement that John Hageman created as of May 24, 2015. To summarize, there was interest income of \$26.13 over last month, and the current balance is \$40,953.42. A copy of the full financial report was emailed out and is attached.

VII. Committee Reports:

a. <u>HazMat Watchdog Committee:</u> (Mike Parsons, William Johnston, Patrick Lewis, Emily Thompson, Ronnie Hernandez, Johnathan Jones, Charlie Metzger)

William Johnston, BCOEM advised that over that past month there was one diesel spill that occurred on June 1, 2015. It was off of Somerset Road, and all of the diesel was contained on the roadway. TxDOT was the first to respond to the incident.

Mike Parsons, SAFD Hazmat presented his incident map. There was approximately nine runs over the past month, and a majority of the incidents were diesel spills. Mike discussed each incident as he highlighted them on the map. The database related to the map is still being worked on, and additional information for the incidents will be added.

William Johnston, BCOEM advised on a gas line rupture that occurred on June 11, 2015 in NE Bexar County. Residents in neighborhood advised to shelter in place, and CPS responded.

Lone Star Bakery located in China Grove provided a notification to BCOEM concerning a 10,000-pound anhydrous ammonia release they had the day before.

Mike Parsons, SAFD Hazmat mentioned that on June 5, 2015 Karnes County notified them of a facility that had a leak of fracking solvent. The proprietary solution was off-gassing and believed to be reacting with something. After much discussion, SAFD did not respond, and status unknown.

b. <u>Training Committee:</u> (Walt Daugherty, Patrick Lewis, William Johnston, Stan Moczgmba)

Walt Daugherty advised that today at 5pm is the deadline for submitting request for reimbursement for responders in Bexar County to attend A&M industrial and municipal training school. It is estimated that per person it costs \$920 to attend the municipal school and \$1245 to attend the industrial school. Walt will notify the departments with of the number of reimbursed training slots they will receive.

Larry Trevino, SAOEM advised on the Joint Counterterrorism Awareness Workshop Series tabletop on June 23-24, 2015 at the convention center offered by DHS.
