

BEXAR COUNTY LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE

Minutes for June 10, 2016

OPENING:

I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at approximately 10:06 a.m. by the LEPC Vice Chair Walt Daugherty. Those in attendance introduced themselves.

II. Attendance:

IV. Approval of Minutes:

Minutes of the May 13, 2016 meeting were distributed to attendees for review.

Mike Broeker made a motion to accept the meetings minutes as written with a correction; the motion was seconded by John Hageman. Motion was approved.

V. Financial Report:

John Hageman provided the information on the financial statement that he created as of May 24, 2016. A copy of the full financial report was emailed out and is attached. To summarize, there was approximately \$26 in interest income, one contribution made by Bexar Metro 911 for \$1910, and three reimbursement checks cleared:

- P. Lewis to attend the Baltimore conference for \$2700;
- M. Wagner to attend the Baltimore conference for \$1814; and
- Alamo Heights FD for \$1910.

The current balance is \$42,399.55.

VII. Committee Reports:

- a. HazMat Watchdog Committee: (Mike Parsons, William Johnston, Patrick Lewis, Emily Thompson, Ronnie Hernandez, Johnathan Jones, Charlie Metzger)

Mike Parsons, SAFD Hazmat, mentioned that there were 17 hazmat runs since last meeting and a majority were fuel spills. He presented an incident map of the 17 hazmat runs. Mike discussed each incident as he highlighted them on the map.

William Johnston, BCOEM, advised on May 31, 2016 there was an overturned 18-wheeler on Ralph Fair Road and approx. 20-gallons spilled out of the saddle tank.

On June 3, 2016 in SW Bexar County a barrel with unknown contents that washed up from the flooding was reported, and turned out to be empty.

Again on June 3, 2016 in Converse a resident called the FD to report a pail with unknown contents found outside of a dumpster. Contents were determined to be film development liquid.

On June 7, 2016 on IH-10 at Trainer Hale there was a small diesel spill from an overturned truck.

- b. Training Committee: (Walt Daugherty, Patrick Lewis, William Johnston, Stan Moczgmba)

Walt Daugherty announced that letters were sent out notifying the position recipients for the July municipal fire school.

Walt Daugherty advised on a LNG/CNG class hosted by the Helotes FD put on by the Railroad Commission and Grey Forest Utilities. In his opinion it was a good class and suggested the LEPC promote this type of class.

- c. Facility Operator Liaison Committee (RMP/Tier II): (Greg Batts, Willie Davis, Frank Salinas, Lynn Lindsay, Abe Gallegos, William Johnston, Steve Diaz, Joe Thaxton)

- d. Exercise Committee: (Henry King, Roger Pollock, Paul Tarter, Willie Davis)

Ed Doss, JBSA, mentioned that JBSA will be conducting an active shooter exercise on July 12-13, 2016. Primarily focused at Randolph, but there will be small involvement at the other two joint base locations.

Dr. Bauer advised on the Rio Grande Valley hurricane evacuation full-scale exercise that took place on June 8-9, 2016. The exercise went okay and there were lessons learned, some similar to lessons in the past such as hydration and wheelchairs. Ed Doss, JBSA, added further detail on the coordination and communication problems encountered. The after action review date is currently unknown.

e. Membership Committee: (Greg Batts, Willie Davis, Kyle Coleman)

Walt Daugherty advised that there is still ongoing discussion and exploration into membership outside of our area.

f. LEPC Website: (Henry Gonzalez, Chair)

John Hageman commented that any information or news reports relating to spent nuclear fuel and/or high level waste traveling through San Antonio is not true.

Damon Shadrock recommended using the WeatherBug free application for smart phones during times of severe weather.

Randy Grimes advised that the Flint Hills and Koch Pipeline Helping Heroes grant program is open again. Deadline to submit applications is August 1, 2016. Walt Daugherty mentioned the Texas LEPC grant program is still in planning stages. Willie Davis has more details on the program that he can provide during next month's meeting.

William Johnston commented that Bexar County and Median County representatives took a tour and performed a dam assessment on Medina Lake dam. They were informed that a reinforcement project was completed back in 2012, and currently the lake is full and flowing over spillway.




