

BEXAR COUNTY LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE

Minutes for March 13, 2015

OPENING:

I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at approximately 10:04 a.m. by the LEPC Chair Harold Lovejoy. Those in attendance introduced themselves.

IV. Approval of Minutes:

Minutes of the February 13, 2015 meeting were distributed to attendees. Walt Daugherty made a motion to accept the minutes as written with a correction; the motion was seconded by Emily Thompson. Motion was approved.

V. Financial Report:

Paul Barrera provided the information on the financial statement that John Hageman created as of February 24, 2015. To summarize, there was a donation of \$2,600 from Flint Hills Resources, no expenses, and interest income of \$25.91 over last month. The current balance is \$40,872.72. A copy of the full financial report was emailed out and is attached.

An audit report was provided by Willie Davis, and everything is in order for the past year (2014).

VII. Committee Reports:

- a. HazMat Watchdog Committee: (Mike Parsons, William Johnston, Patrick Lewis, Emily Thompson, Ronnie Hernandez, Johnathan Jones, Charlie Metzger)

Mike Parsons, SAFD Hazmat, advised that on February 16, 2015 there was a trench rescue downtown, and air monitoring was conducted but nothing was found. Incident was at Alamo Street and Cesar Chavez.

On February 17, 2015 the new owners of a property near the airport found abandoned trash cans containing a liquid. Liquid turned out to be solvent left from previous business. Due to situations like this, it may be helpful for LEPC to add information on hazardous substance disposal to the website.

On February 24, 2015 a coal dust explosion occurred at Capital Cement. Incident not considered a hazmat specific release, and a few workers did receive burns.

On February 25, 2015 a plane crashed at Government Canyon. No hazmat release occurred from this incident.

On February 25, 2015 a natural gas explosion occurred at a house. Leak was stopped.

On February 25, 2015 there was a carbon monoxide response on Vera Cruz. Building was ventilated.

On February 25, 2015 a storage shed with 3 drums marked radiation was reported. The drums turned out to be empty old drums from pipe surveying equipment left inside the storage shed.

On February 25, 2015 there was a carbon monoxide response on New Braunfels Ave. Foreign nationals were Bar-B-Qing inside of the house.

On February 27, 2015 there was a spill at I-37 and New Braunfels Ave. No spill amounts were reported.

On March 3, 2015 there was a spill on Highcliff of 30-gallons of diesel that was remediated onsite.

On March 6, 2015 at I-10 and W.W. White there was an overturned dump truck that lost 40-gallons of hydraulic fluid.

On March 11, 2015 there was an overturned intermodal container carrying penta fluoro propane on I-35 south. There was no loss of product from the container, and maybe one gallon of hydraulic fluid spilled.

Walt Daugherty advised that he had a phone conversation earlier today with Bexar Metro 911 and was told verbally that the request was approved for up to \$16,000 for reimbursement for responders in Bexar County to attend A&M training school in July.

Dr. Bauer provided information on the STRAC conference scheduled for May 4-6, 2015 at the Alamo Dome. A flyer was provided during the meeting. There will be four tracks: Trauma, Disaster, Stroke and Cardiac. Today is the last day for early-bird registration.

Dr. Bauer mentioned there is a decontamination training opportunity through STRAC on March 17th and 18th at University Hospital. March 17, 2015 is Decon Train-the-trainer and you must have knowledge of decon to attend. March 18, 2015 course will provide initial decon training.

Lizette Villarreal advised that the Poison Center will be having an exercise related to their flu on-call project at the CDC on September 9-10, 2015. They will focus on setting up the infrastructure to handle flu and Ebola calls.

Miguel Falcon advised that there will be a hospital exercise focusing on evacuation on April 8, 2015.

National Homeland Security Conference is June 9-11, 2015 at Henry B Gonzalez Convention Center.


Emergency Management Conference is in May 12-15, 2015 at Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center.
