get2getherlocally CIC runs Hilary’s Hut, a free over 45’s social meet up group for ‘active adults’ to combat loneliness in the community.

A key value of G2GL is that all activities are provided free of charge (or at a subsidised rate/ donation) as being alone is not to be profited from. Time Agreed	Attend a quarterly Management Committee Meetings (2-3hrs per meeting) 8hrs per month administration at own convenience. *Optional to attend the quarterly Volunteer Team Meetings of Hilary’s Hut (2-3hrs per meeting).
Purpose	Work with the Directors and Treasurer to ensure statutory compliance of Accounts.
Tasks to include	The key tasks of the Finance Director are Ensuring that proper accounting records are kept, and that appropriate accounting procedures and controls are in place. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To report the state of finances at all meetings and to invite questions. • To prepare the annual statement of accounts for approval. • To set up and act as a co-signature on the bank account. • Overseeing the presentation of budgets, internal management accounts and annual financial statements to the Board. • Ensuring that robust and comprehensive financial policies are in place and being implemented, and supporting the development of policies covering financial reserves, and cost management. • Monitoring and advising on the financial viability of the CIC. • Advising on the financial implications of the strategic plan. • Lead on the appointment of and liaison with external auditors. • Ensuring that the accounts are prepared and disclosed in the form required by relevant statutory bodies, for example, the Charity Commission and/or Companies House/HMRC. • Keeping the board informed about its financial duties and responsibilities and liaising with the Directors to develop the financial understanding of the Board. • To be loyal to the committee - respect confidentiality

Responsibilities of all Directors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support and provide advice on G2GL’s purpose, vision, goals, and activities. • Approve operational strategies, policies, and monitor and evaluate their implementation. • Oversee G2GL’s financial plans and budgets and monitor and evaluate progress. • Ensure the effective and efficient administration of the organisation. • Keep abreast of changes in charity sector’s operating environment. • Contribute to regular reviews of G2GL’s own governance. • Attend Board meetings and be adequately prepared to contribute to discussions. • Use independent judgment, acting legally and in good faith to promote and protect G2GL’s interests, to the exclusion of their own personal and/or any third-party interests. • Contribute to the broader promotion of objectives, aims and reputation by applying your skills, expertise, knowledge, and contacts.
