CANCELLATIONS, SUBSTITUTIONS & REFUND POLICY

- Cancellations made before the closing date of the show will receive a full refund;
- Cancellations made after the closing date of the show will forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian or physician is presented to the office before the start of classes. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all cancellations.
- Cancellations made after the start of competition will receive a 50% refund of the remaining entries if the appropriate Doctor's note or Veterinary certificate is presented to the office before the end of the show.
- With a Veterinary certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse; \$20 fee;
- All entries received after the closing date are subject to a \$20 late entry fee;

STABLING

Stalls: \$35.00 (\$25.00 for KRC members)

Stall Deposit of \$35 is required on a separate cheque. This cheque will be refunded after the stall is cleaned before your departure.

All stalls must be cleaned at the end of your show.

SHOW INFORMATION

Show office: to open at 8 am first class to start at 9:00 am

- Each horse/rider combination must be entered in a separate entry form; all fees must accompany the entry form;
- Appropriate footwear must be worn when mounted;
- All Riders mounted on a horse must wear ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets with safety harness correctly fastened at all the times while on the competition grounds;
- Only Senior Riders may ride or handle stallions anywhere on the competition grounds;
- Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas, as well as in the competition ring. Failure to display number may result in elimination or disqualification;
- Only horses registered in the show are allowed on the grounds during the competition days;
- Any contestant demonstrating unsafe or unsportsmanlike behavior in the opinion of the judge will be disqualified for the remainder of the show without refund or entry fees;
- Dogs must be kept on leashes and kept in the trailer parking area; you are encouraged to leave your dog at home;
- Lunging is only allowed in the lunging ring.
- Take practice fences so the red flag is on your right;
- An adult must be present when a junior rider is jumping in the warm-up ring;
- The management reserves the right to limit entries, or refuse an entry;
- The management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes depending on the number of entries received;
- The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and correct any error or omission in the program;
- Protests or objections will be handled by the management.

WARMUPS: Friday, June 14, 2019, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

CAMPERS & TRAILERS: Limited camper and trailer parking is available on the show grounds in Designated areas.

NO HOOKUPS! Showers and washroom facilities are available at no charge.

All owners, riders, trainers/coaches and persons responsible must be current HCBC or AEF members and current.

SHOEING: All Jumper and Dressage rings are sand, Derby may have grass.

SHOW INFORMATION

CONCUSSIONS: Accidents & Return to Play Rule: In the event of a fall/accident where a concussion can be reasonably suspected, the competitors must receive medical clearance by qualified medical personnel onsite before continuing to compete. The competitor is solely responsible for ensuring the onsite medical assessment takes place. Should a competitor refuse to be evaluated, they will be disqualified from the competition. If onsite qualified medical personnel suspect a concussion or believe the competitor may be at risk of concussion due to the nature of the fall or impact, the competitor will be suspended from competition and placed on a Medical Suspension List until medically released. Competitors will remain on the EC Medical Suspension List until they submit an EC Return to Play Form, signed by a licensed physician, to EC. No competitor shall compete at EC sanctioned competitions while on the EC Medical Suspension List and competition organizers may refuse entry to anyone currently on the list.

DRESS/ATTIRE: All competitors must be properly dressed in the confines of the arena. This includes the inspection of the course and at the presentation of prizes. Black or brown smooth leather half chaps are permissible providing they match the boot colour. In jumper competitions open-neck polo shirts are allowed. No sweatshirts, t-shirts, tank tops or other similar dress will be permitted. Shirts must be neatly tucked into riding breeches. Article G109.2.

EARPHONES/EARBUDS: Earphones/Earbuds and/or other electronic communication devices are strictly prohibited in the competition arena, and such usage is penalized by elimination. The use of only one earphone/ earbud is allowed while mounted everywhere within the grounds of the Event except the competition arena.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Open/Senior Riders are 19 years of age or over as of December 31 of the previous year;
- Junior/Youth are 18 years and under;
- Where 'no cross entries are allowed', this refers to one specific horse/rider combination;

SHOW INFORMATION

1. This competition will be conducted under the rules and regulations contained herein and will conform to EC rules as applicable, including the following:

2. **The Jumping Phase** rules and scoring will conform to the current EC Rules for Show Jumping. Dimensions of obstacles will be according to the EC Rules for Eventing of the current year.

A. **Jumping Phase Only Class:** Specify on your entry form which Height you wish to ride.

C. **Levels:** A horse may not be entered in more than two (2) consecutive levels for jumping (i.e., Pre-Training and Training)

D. **Jumping Phase Dress and Saddlery:** EC Rules

E. **Errors or deviations from the prescribed course are penalized as follows:**

First disobedience	4 penalties
Second disobedience	8 penalties
Third disobedience on course	Elimination
Knockdown	4 penalties
First fall of competitor or horse	Elimination
Exceeding the optimum time (per second)	.25 penalty
Exceeding the time limit	Elimination
Error of course not rectified	Elimination
Leaving arena area	Elimination

3. **The Dressage Phase** will be scored on a penalty point basis; as in Eventing, the competitor with the lowest score will win that division of the competition, when entered in the 2 phase section.

A. **Dressage Test Only Class:** EC tests will also be offered. Specify on your entry form which tests you wish to ride.

B. **Arena Size:** Dressage tests (All Walk/Trot tests) will be ridden in a small (20x40m) arena) All others in a (20mX60m). All Event tests to be ridden in small (20X40m) arena except Training level (20mX60m)

D. **Show attire and Braiding:** optional.

4. Whenever horses are tied in the final classification, the horse with the least number of faults (jumping and time) in the Jumping phase shall be placed first. If still tied, the best score of the collective marks of the Dressage shall prevail. If still tied, placings and awards are to be duplicated.

5. Use of non-standard equipment, trainer's schooling horses, or other deviations from EC Rules may be allowed with permission from show management and riding hors de concours (HC) may be required.
