**Description:** Join me as we explore human anatomy in this cadaver anatomy class. We will have access to embalmed cadavers that have been previously dissected to reveal the musculo-skeletal system, fascial layers and visceral attachments. We will be able to examine the major nerves and vasculature. We also have a donor upon which we may do our own dissection. The format of this class is immersive and hands on. No dissection experience is needed. You have the choice on how much interaction with each donor is

comfortable for you. The ability to move and examine all dissected structures enhances the learning experience.

## **Class Objectives:**

Review and identify the following structures of the body

- muscles of the back, chest, abdomen, neck, shoulder, arm and hand.
- muscles of the hip and pelvis, thigh, lower leg and foot.
- neurovascular of upper body
- neurovascular of lower body
- major arthrology
- organs in the thoracic and abdominal region
- distinguish between fascial layers
